<p align="center">Men's Ice Hockey</p> <p align="center">Dead Periods</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • November 7-10, 2011, (during the period Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent). • April 9-12, 2012, (during the period Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the spring signing of the National Letter of Intent). • April 4-8 (noon), 2012, (Wednesday prior to the Division I Men's Ice Hockey Championship to noon on the Sunday after the game).
<p align="center">Women's Ice Hockey</p> <p align="center">Dead and Quiet Periods</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • November 7-10, 2011, (during the period Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent) • March 15-19 (noon), 2012, (the day prior to the Division I Women's Ice Hockey Championship to noon on the day after the game). • April 9-12, 2012, (during the period Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the spring signing of the National Letter of Intent). • April 23 through May 31 2012, is considered a quiet period. [Monday prior to the American Hockey Coaches Association Convention (April 26-29)].
