

## Multiple SAT or ACT Scores

The Eligibility Center will mix and match scores to achieve the best result. For example, if a student takes the SAT more than once, the Eligibility Center will use the best sub score (critical reading and math) from different test dates to meet the minimum test-score requirements. The same would be true for ACT. The Eligibility Center will use the best English, math, reading and science sub scores from different test dates to get the student the best result.

Here is an example:

	Math	Critical Reading	Total Score
SAT (10-09)	350	<b>470</b>	820
SAT (12-09)	<b>420</b>	440	860
Scores Used	<b>420</b>	<b>470</b>	<b>890</b>

**Bold** indicates best score.
