

Removing Courses No Longer Taught

Don't be afraid! You can remove courses you no longer teach and not be afraid that they are gone forever. We hold these old course titles in our system for future use, even though you cannot see them on your active list.

So, if you stopped teaching Shakespeare in at the end of the 2006-2007 school year, you can go ahead and remove it from your list, even though students who took it in 2006-07 may still be coming through the Eligibility Center in the future. We will keep Shakespeare in our system to use for those students. Some schools like to keep their courses on their list until the last class that could have taken that course has graduated. That's fine, too.

What difference does it make? A leaner list will help the list's users (students, parents, coaches) find active courses more easily, and keeps your list a manageable length.
