What is year nine called?	Typically year nine
Where is year nine typically located?	Typically ninth year of primary school or second year of lower secondary school
Native Language(s)	Varies dependent upon the country in which the school is located
GRADUATION TIMELINE	
$9 + 2 + 2 = 13$ or $6 + 7 = 13$	13 years total: nine years primary, two years lower secondary, two years upper secondary or six years lower secondary and seven years of upper secondary
