Where is year nine typically located?	Fifth year of lower secondary school
Native Language(s)	Lithuanian
Graduation Timeline	
4 + 6 + 2 = 12	12 years total: four years primary, six years lower secondary and two years upper secondary

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PROOF OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

1. *Brandos Atestatas* [Maturity Certificate]

Expected Timeline of Completion	12 years total (four years or eight semesters from the initial start of year nine)
Issuing Body	Upper Secondary School (typically on Ministry letterhead)

2. *Taikomuju Mokslu Vidurines Mokyklos Brandos Atestats* [Maturity Certificate of Applied Sciences Secondary School]

Expected Timeline of Completion	12 years total (four years or eight semesters from the initial start of year nine)
Issuing Body	Upper Secondary School (typically on Ministry letterhead)

3. Qualifications obtained after successful completion of vocational school (if “Secondary Education Obtained” [*Igijo Vidurini Issilavinima*] is inscribed)

Expected Timeline of Completion	12 years total (four years or eight semesters from the initial start of year nine)
Issuing Body	Upper Secondary School (typically on Ministry letterhead)

NOT ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PROOF OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

1. *Paragrindinio Issilavinimo Paztvejimo* [Year 10 Basic Education Certificate]

Expected Timeline of Completion	10 years (two years or four semesters from the initial start of year nine)
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2. *Pagrindines Mokyklos Baigimo Pazymejimas* (PMP) [Certificate of Completion of Basic Education]

Expected Timeline of Completion	10 years (two years or four semesters from the initial start of year nine)
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3. *Metu Profesines Vidurines Mokyklos Kolegijos Atestatas* [Certificate of Vocational Secondary School]

Expected Timeline of Completion	11 years (three years or six semesters from the initial start of year nine)
