First Available Date of Issue (Typical)	May/June

NOT ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PROOF OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

1. *Diplôme national du brevet* (national certificate)

Expected Timeline of Completion	9 years (one or two semesters from the initial start of year nine)
Issuing Body	Lower Secondary School
First Available Date of Issue (Typical)	May/June
