Expected Timeline of Completion	12 years (four years or eight semesters from the initial start of year nine)
Issuing Body	Secondary school

Important Information

- » If the Lower Slutbetyg (year nine certificate) only lists science and social science as two single courses with no individual subject breakdowns, then award 0.5 credit each to biology, physics and chemistry at the grade awarded for the science course and 0.5 credit each to history, geography and civics at the grade awarded for social science course.
- » The following are less commonly known course titles **approved** for use in an academic certification:

- » The following course titles have been reviewed and are not approved for use in an academic certification:
 - Communications.
 - Diploma project.
 - General knowledge of languages.
 - Linguistic awareness.
 - Private Law.
 - Religion (taken in year nine).
 - Rhetoric.
- » How to locate a date of birth on a transcript/certificate:
 - The first six digits of the “National ID number” listed on the transcript are the date of birth.
 - Formatted YYMMDD (year year month month day day).
Example: National ID number 960406-1234 (Date of birth would be April 6, 1996).
- » Swedish documents will be tasked for by title, not by a period of time.
