New Model	Transcript-based analysis to determine NCAA initial-eligibility requirements (same as a domestic/U.S. transcript review). Click here to view.

TERM	EXPLANATION
Old Model	International academic certification methodology that utilized a "category system" for leaving certificates and leaving examinations to determine NCAA initial eligibility. Click here to view.
POG	Proof of graduation.
RTP	Ready to process.
RTP-Final	Ready for a final academic evaluation. All transcripts, proof of high school graduation and an active IRL for the current cycle must be on file with the Eligibility Center.
RTP-Preliminary	Ready for a preliminary academic evaluation. An official transcript from all schools listed in NCAA account and an active IRL for the current cycle must be on file with the Eligibility Center.
