- Current, signed documentation of the EID diagnosis (including test data) and/or recommendations from the treating professional (e.g., medical doctor, clinical psychologist or another qualified individual).
- Copy of the student's most recent individual education plan, Section 504 plan or, for private high schools, a statement on the high school's letterhead describing the accommodations, if any, received by the student because of the EID.
- The student's NCAA ID, high school graduation year, permanent address and phone number should be included with the aforementioned documentation.
- Signed [Buckley Statement](#)—**required** for the NCAA to discuss the student's EID request with anyone other than the student. A parent/legal guardian who would like to discuss a student's EID request with the NCAA *must be listed* on the Buckley Statement.
