



## Electronic Transcripts

The NCAA Eligibility Center will accept official electronic transcripts from any of the following service providers. Sending transcripts through an approved electronic transcript service or using the NCAA Eligibility Center's direct upload feature is the most efficient way to send transcripts. Electronic transcripts are received and processed within 24 hours. Below is a list of the approved electronic transcript providers:

High schools now have the capability to upload transcripts directly to a student's account from the High School Portal. It's free and easy! As with other electronic transcript providers, this process is much quicker than using the U.S. Postal Service or any overnight delivery method. When transcripts are uploaded directly to a student's account, the NCAA Eligibility Center has near real time access to the transcript!
