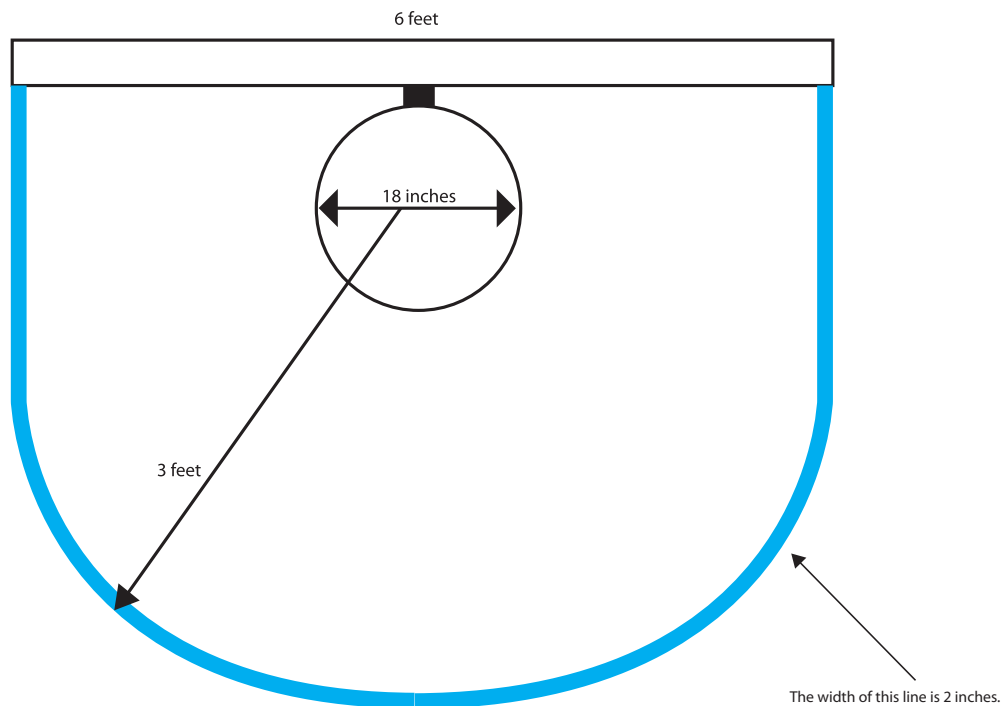


NCAA Men's and Women's Basketball

3-Foot Restricted Area Arc

Baseline



INSTRUCTIONS

1. To place the arc on the floor, mark a spot on the floor directly under the center of the basket.
2. Using a measuring device, create a semicircle that extends three feet from the center of the basket.
3. Measure several points from the center of the basket, including two points along a plane parallel to the backboard.
4. The restricted area arc shall be drawn as a two-inch line with the outer edge of the line measuring three feet from the center of the basket.
5. At the diameter points of the semicircle (the plane parallel to the backboard), the line straightens, similar to the three-point line.
6. The arc's straight lines shall end at the front edge of the backboard.
7. The line must be clear and discernable from the surrounding area. It is recommended that the line be the same color as the lane lines or end lines.
