

3-Foot Restricted Area Arc

Baseline



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. To place the arc on the floor, mark a spot on the floor directly under the center of the basket.
- 2. Using a measuring device, create a semicircle that extends three feet from the center of the basket.
- 3. Measure several points from the center of the basket, including two points along a plane parallel to the backboard.
- 4. The restricted area arc shall be drawn as a two-inch line with the outer edge of the line measuring three feet from the center of the basket.
- 5. At the diameter points of the semicircle (the plane parallel to the backboard), the line straightens, similar to the three-point line.
- 6. The arc's straight lines shall end at the front edge of the backboard.
- 7. The line must be clear and discernable from the surrounding area. It is recommended that the line be the same color as the lane lines or end lines.
