2000 Championships

Highlights

Tigers Claw Back for Title: LSU staged a dramatic rally on the final day of the championships May 31-June 3 at Duke, capped by Keisha Spencer's triple-jump win.

The Tigers, who earned their 12th title, scored 46 of their 58 points in the nine finals contested on the concluding day. Southern California had its best finish ever, placing second with 54 points.

LSU's effort was also sparked by individual victories by Peta-Gaye Dowdie in the 200-meter dash and Joyce Bates in the 100-meter high hurdles. Angela Williams won the 100-meter dash for the Trojans, and was the only repeat champion from 1999.

Natasha Danvers was another individual champion for Southern California in the 400-meter intermediate hurdles, and the Trojans' 400 relay unit also placed first.

UCLA's Seilala Sua became the championships' career leader in individual titles with six after capturing the shot put and discus throw. Sua won the discus throw in each of her four seasons and the shot put as a junior and senior.

Meet records were set by UCLA's Tracy O'Hara in the pole vault, Southern Methodist's Florence Ezeh in the hammer throw and UTEP's Angeliki Tsiolakoudi in the javelin throw.

Highlights

Falcons Keep Trophy from Leaving the Nest: St. Augustine's hosted the championships in its home city May 25-27, then went about making sure the championship trophy would not return home with one of the visitors.

The Falcons used a strong performance from Tanya Oxley to record their second title, posting 77 points at North Carolina State. Two-time defending champion Abilene Christian was second with 66 points.

Oxley sprinted to victories in the 200- and 400-meter dashes, and was a member of St. Augustine's victorious 400- and 1,600-meter relay teams. Adriane Sims also was a winner for the Falcons, capturing the high jump.

Abilene Christian extended its streak of finishing first or second in the team scoring to eight years with its third runner-up effort. The Wildcats had three individual champions – Shawntel Newhouse in the 100-meter high hurdles, Meredith Garner in the pole vault and Geraldine George in the javelin throw.

Garner's winning vault of 13 feet, 1½ inches, and George's top throw of 165 feet, 4 inches, were meet records. Northern Colorado's Kim Schiemenz added a third record with 5,602 points in the heptathlon.

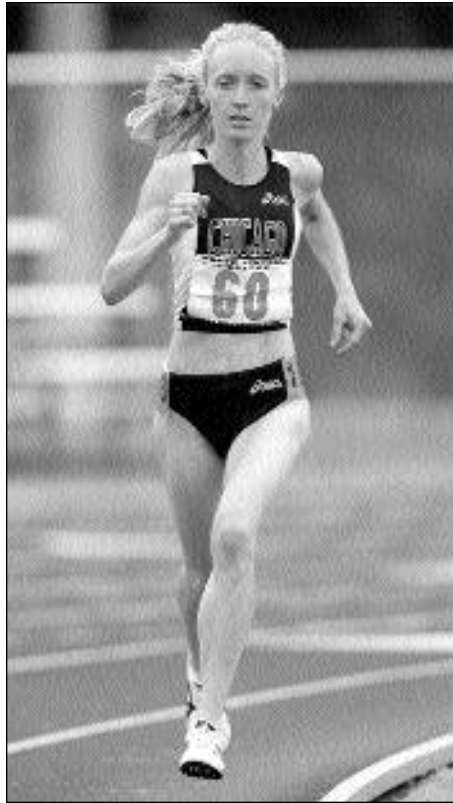

Highlights

Jones' Triple Puts Lions in Lead: Rhondale Jones beat the sophomore slump, and in turn, Lincoln (Pennsylvania) repeated as champion May 25-27 at North Central.

Lincoln compiled 65 points, with Christopher Newport second with 50 and Wheaton (Massachusetts) third with 48½.

Jones was responsible for three of Lincoln's four individual victories, as she repeated her 1999 wins as a freshman in the 100- and 200-meter dashes, and the 100-meter high hurdles. She is the first athlete in the championships' history to win three events in a meet more than once.

Zanora Berry gave Lincoln a sweep of the hurdle events, as she won the 400-meter intermediate hurdles.

Casey Taylor accounted for over half of Christopher Newport's points, as she won the long jump, came in second in both the triple jump and 100 hurdles, and placed seventh in the high jump.

The pole vault is now a part of all the NCAA women's track and field championships after debuting in the Division III outdoor meet this year. Laura Rosenberger of Eastern Mennonite earned the distinction of being the first winner, just as she did at the indoor championship, by clearing the bar at 11 feet, 11¾ inches.
