Highlights

Giant-Killer Georgia: Second-ranked Georgia stopped previously unbeaten and No. 1-ranked Stanford to capture the program's second national title with a 5-4 win at the Division I Women's Tennis Championships. Defending champion Stanford, 30-1, had its 46-match winning streak snapped and was denied its 11th NCAA crown.

After splitting the singles, 3-3, Georgia took the lead when the duo of Esther Knox and Aarthi Venkatesan captured a quick 8-3 win at No. 2 doubles. Stanford's Lauren Kalvaria and Gabriela Lastra returned the favor and evened the match by scoring a comfortable 8-2 decision at No. 3.

In the deciding doubles finale, Georgia's second-ranked duo of Marissa Catlin and Lori Grey bolted to a 6-1 advantage, only to find themselves suddenly down, 7-6, to Stanford's fourth-ranked Teryn Ashley and Marissa Irvin. Catlin-Grey battled for an 8-8 tie, fell behind 2-0 in the tiebreaker, then rallied for a 7-3 triumph to garner the title.

Individual doubles play produced the first three-time NCAA champion as California's Amy Jensen teamed with Claire Curran to defeat Catlin-Grey in the final. Jensen also won for the Bears in 1998 and 1999 with former teammate Amanda Augustus.

In singles competition, Stanford freshman Laura Granville became the ninth Cardinal player to win the women's singles title by defeating teammate Irvin, 6-0, 6-4.

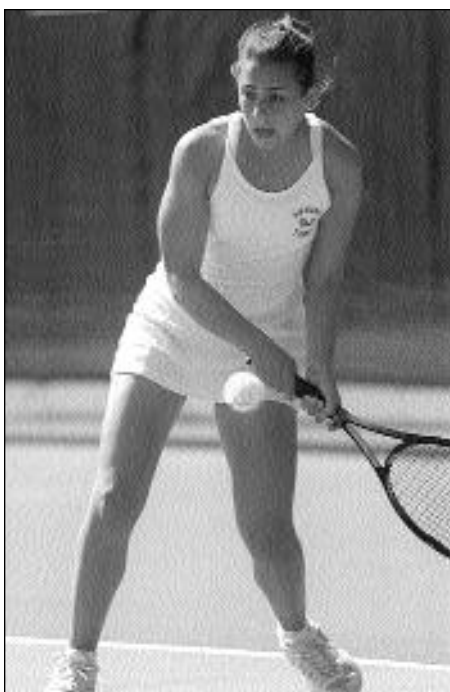
