



## CWS Game 2 Notes: Florida vs. Miami (Fla.)

Saturday, June 13, 2015

**Florida 15, Miami (Fla.) 3 – Attendance 26,377 (MCWS Total: 50,605; Avg. 25,304) – Time of Game: 3:29**

### Florida (50-16):

- Florida (No. 4 National Seed) and Miami (No. 5 National Seed) will meet for the first time in Omaha ... UF is made its first College World Series appearance since 2012, while Miami is back in Omaha for the first time since 2008 ...
- This is the ninth time the Gators have reached the CWS (1988, 1991, 1996, 1998, 2005, 2010-2012, 2015) ...
- Florida has made the NCAA Tournament in all eight years of Kevin O'Sullivan's tenure – the longest NCAA run in school history ...
- O'Sullivan owns a 7-0 all-time record against the Hurricanes in NCAA Tournament play (Miami has won 12 of the 22 contests between the two schools in NCAA Tournament action) ... He has a 4-6 all-time in the CWS guiding the Gators to a second-place finish in 2011 ...
- UF is 12-17 all-time in the CWS and is a two-time National runner-up (2005 and 2011) ... They sport a 91-64 record in 31 NCAA Tournament appearances ...
- The Gators reached the 50-win plateau for the fourth time in school history having hit the mark in 1991 (51-21), 1996 (50-18), 2011 (53-19) and 2015 (50-16) ...
- Florida improves to 4-5 in CWS first round games after the win tonight ...
- The Gators have now claimed 20 of the last 25 meetings with the Hurricanes, including three of the four this season ...
- The 12-run victory is the largest margin of defeat against Miami since Feb. 14, 1998 when they topped the Canes 19-5 in Gainesville ... It's also O'Sullivan's largest margin of defeat against Miami in his eight-year head coaching career ...
- UF collected its 20th come-from-behind win of the season after trailing 2-0 in the third inning ...
- Logan Shore picked up his 10th win of the season in first career CWS start (18th of the season, which leads the team) ... He allowed three runs (two earned) on seven hits in five-plus innings while striking out six ... In four NCAA Tournament starts this year, he owns a 3-1 record having surrendered six runs (five earned) on 23 hits with 19 strikeouts to five walks ...
- JJ Schwarz extended his current hit streak to 12 games (career-long) with a single to left in the second inning ... Drove in two runs (his 16th multi-RBI game of the season) ... Finished the contest 2-for-4 with two RBI and two runs scored ...
- Dalton Guthrie extended his on-base streak to 17 games (season-high) with a single to left in the third frame ... Recorded his 23rd multi-hit game of the season with a 3-for-3 performance, which is tied for second with Schwarz (23) and trails on Josh Tobais (25)...
- Tobias' walk to start the fourth extend his on-base streak to a season-high 28 games ... Finished the game 1-for-4 with three RBI and two runs scored ...
- UF's 11-run fourth inning set a TDAPO record for runs in a single frame (previous was nine by Vanderbilt in 2013 CWS Finals against Virginia) ... It's the eighth time in CWS that a team has scored 11 runs in an inning and first since Stanford (vs. Florida State) in the ninth on June 14, 2008 – final score was 16-5 ... Marks the highest run outing of the season and in the Gators NCAA history ...
- During the 11-run fourth, Buddy Reed and Mike Rivera both collected two hits (all singles) marking the first time since 2002 that teammates collected multiple hits in the same inning (Michael Johnson/2 doubles and Roberto Valiente/single and double vs. Georgia Tech on June 16) ...
- Also Reed, Schwarz and Tobias all scored twice in the fourth frame ...
- UF's 15 runs are the most by a CWS team in one game since 2008 (Fresno State 19, Georgia 10 – June 24) ... It's also the third most this season for the Gators (they scored 22 against Rhode Island/Feb. 14 and Stetson/April 7) ...
- In 6 NCAA Tournament games, Florida has outscored teams 68-15 (29-3 in Regionals, 24-9 in Super's, 15-3 in CWS) ...
- The Gators scored seven two-out runs on four two-out hits ...

#### **Miami (Fla.) (49-16):**

- The Hurricanes (No. 5 National Seed) advanced to their 24th College World Series in program history (1974, 1978, 1979, 1980, 1981, 1982, 1984, 1985, 1986, 1988, 1989, 1992, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2001, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2015) ... Only Texas with 35 CWS appearances has more ...
- Miami won the national championship in 1982, 1985, 1999 and 2001 ...
- In 2015, Miami is 7-3 in the postseason: 2-1 in the ACC Tournament, 3-1 in the Coral Gables Regional, 2-0 in the Coral Gables Super Regional and 0-1 in the CWS ...
- The Hurricanes are participating in their NCAA record 43rd-straight postseason ...
- Florida is the only current Division I opponent that Miami played in its first season of baseball (1940) ... The Gators defeated the Hurricanes 18-13 in the first meeting, but Miami leads the all-time series 127-113-1 ... Florida won three of four meetings this season (4-3, 2-7, 2-1, Feb. 20-22 in Gainesville and 15-3 tonight) ...
- Miami lost for just the third time in its last 22 games ...
- David Thompson's two sacrifice flies tied a CWS record (shared with 14 others) ... Thompson' two RBI raised his NCAA-leading total to 89 ...
- Eight pitchers used by Miami tied a CWS record set by North Carolina against Rice, June 7, 2007 and tied three times prior to Miami (Arkansas vs. LSU, June 19, 2009; Florida State vs. Arizona, May 21, 2012; North Carolina vs. North Carolina State, June 16, 2013) ...
- The 12-run loss is the largest margin of defeat in Miami's postseason history ...

### 2015 College World Series Notes

#### **Records Tied/Broken**

- David Thompson has tied a CWS single-game record with two sac flies in the contest ... It has happened 15 times and it's the first since June 13, 2009 ... He is also the first player in TDAPO history (span of 206 games) with two sac flies in the same contest ... Before today there had been 122 players with a sac fly – never two by the same player ...
- Florida scored 11 runs in the fourth inning, which tied a CWS single-game record ... It's the eighth time in CWS history that a team has scored 11 runs in an inning and first since Stanford (vs. Florida State) in the ninth on June 14, 2008 – final score was 16-5 ...
- Florida's 15 runs against Miami are the most in a CWS game at TDAPO and most since Fresno State's 15-run output against Georgia on June 24, 2008, which was at Rosenblatt Stadium ...
- Miami used eight pitchers against Florida in Game which ties a CWS team record ... It's the fifth time eight hurlers has been used in a single game and first since North Carolina vs. NC State on June 6, 2013 in an 8-1 setback ...

#### **Attendance Notes:**

- Game two attendance between Miami and Florida was announced as 26,377 which is the 19th largest in CWS history and fourth largest in TDAPO ...

#### **Home Run Notes:**

- Joe McCarthy (UVa) and Andrew Benintendi (Arkansas) each belted solo home runs in Game 1 of the CWS marking the 17th time (in 205 games at TDAPO) with two home runs in a game (never had a three in one game) ... Last time with two home runs in a CWS game was in 2012 (Game 11) FSU vs. Arizona (Robert Refsnyder and Bobby Brown hit home runs in the same game) ... Last time two home runs in a game (one by each team) was in 2012 (Game 3/ Kent State vs. Arkansas) ... Jimmy Rider (Kent State) and Jake Wise (Arkansas) ...
- Joe McCarthy's (UVa) home run in the second inning is the first in Game 1 of CWS since Stony Brook's Pat Cantwell in 2012 against UCLA ...
- Andrew Benintendi (Arkansas) belted a solo home run in the fifth inning, which is his nation-leading 20th of the year ...
- The two home runs mark the 26th and 27th in CWS play at TD Ameritrade Park Omaha (61st CWS game in park history) ... CWS home runs at TD Ameritrade Park including both Saturday shots: LF/12, LCF/5, CF/0, RCF/0 and RF/10 ...

#### **Runs Breakdown Notes:**

- After two games of the 2015 CWS, 18 of the 26 runs scored (69.2%) have been driven in via a hit ...
- In other words, eight of the 26 seven runs (30.8%) have scored as a result of something other than a hit ...
- Actual scoring breakdown: hits (18), sacrifices (4), groundout/fielder's choice (1), balk (1) and error (1) ...
- The 26 runs scored through two games of the CWS are the most since 30 in 2009 ...

#### **Hit Notes:**

- Through two games there have been 42 hits with 10 going for extra bases (two home runs, eight doubles) ... Two of the 32 hits on day one came via an infield singles ...

#### **Stolen Base Notes:**

- Daniel Pinero swiped three of Virginia's five bases becoming the first player with three stolen bases in a CWS game since Brad Boyer (Arizona) vs. Arkansas on June 20, 2004 ... He is the third player in TDAPO history with three steals in a game (first in the CWS at TDAPO) ... Also, he is the 22nd player in CWS history with at least three base thefts in a contest ...
- Both teams combined for six stolen bases, which are the most in a CWS since that same Brad Boyer game on June 20, 2004 (Arizona vs. Arkansas) ...

#### **Taking The Lead Notes:**

- The last 69 teams to take a lead to the 9th inning at the CWS have won ... Last team to lose a game with the lead after eight innings was Texas on June 22, 2009 to LSU in game one of the Championship Series ... Texas led that game 6-4 and lost 7-6 in 11 innings ...
