2000 Championships

Highlights

Razorbacks Triumph in Wintry Weather: Braving temperatures in the teens and a wind-chill factor below zero, four Arkansas runners placed among the first 24 finishers to give Arkansas its third straight title November 20 at Iowa State.

The Razorbacks scored 83 team points to edge Colorado's total of 94 and secure their division-best 11th championship. The 11-point advantage marked Arkansas' smallest margin of victory in a championship since a 10-point win over Arizona for its first title in 1984.

James Karanu was the first Razorback to finish, completing the 10,000-meter course in 30 minutes, 42.7 seconds and in 11th place. Teammates Sharif Karie and Murray Link were close behind, finishing 13th and 16th, respectively.

Keith Kelly became Providence's first individual champion. Kelly, who registered a time of 30 minutes, 14.5 seconds over the 10,000-meter course, edged Fairleigh Dickinson's Stephen Ondieki by 1.8 seconds.
