Highlights

Purple Raiders Return to Top: Mount Union cast itself into the champion's role once again with a last-second 10-7 win over St. John's (Minnesota) December 16 in Salem, Virginia.

Rodney Chenos booted a 20-yard field goal with just one second remaining in regulation. The successful kick lifted Mount Union to its fourth title in the last five years, and gave the Purple Raiders their division-leading fifth championship overall.

Mount Union jumped out to a 7-0 lead, taking the opening kickoff and driving 62 yards. Quarterback Gary Smeck hit Adam Irgang from eight yards out for the touchdown.

The Johnnies knotted the score on a one-yard run by Chris Moore in the second quarter.

Each team had three interceptions, including two by St. John's Will Gibson. Mount Union limited the Johnnies to 207 total yards.

Mount Union's Chuck Moore topped all rushers with 146 yards on 32 carries. Smeck completed 19 of 27 attempts for 144 yards. He established a tournament record for completion percentage at .696, after connecting on 80 of 115 throws.

St. John's (Minnesota), which concluded its season with a 13-2 record, was led by Chris Moore's 71 yards rushing on 22 carries.

Mount Union was undefeated in 14 games in 2000, and its only loss in the last five years was to Rowan in the 1999 semifinals.
