## 2001 Championships

### Highlights

**Cougars Extend Odd Run:** Brigham Young ran its streak of winning the championship in odd-numbered years to three November 19 at Furman.

The Cougars added to their 1997 and 1999 titles with a dominant performance, winning by 86 points over North Carolina State. All five Brigham Young scorers placed in the top 25 as they combined for a team count of 62 points.

The margin of victory is the second-largest in the championships' history, bettered only by Villanova's 90-point triumph in 1990.

Michaela Manova started the procession of Cougars across the finish line, coming in fifth. Jessie Kindschi was two spots behind Manova, and Tara Northcutt two places after Kindschi.

Kristin Price led North Carolina State with a fourth-place finish. The Wolfpack made its division-leading 19th team appearance in the championships, and the runner-up effort equaled its best showing.

Tara Chaplin of Arizona beat the course record by two seconds in winning the individual title. The Wildcat registered a time of 20:24, seven seconds better than second-place finisher Renee Metivier of Georgia Tech.

## 2001 Championships

### Highlights

**Mountaineers Stay at Top:** Western State finished second six times during Adams State's run of eight straight titles in the championships from 1992-99.

The Mountaineers snapped Adams State's streak in 2000 and showed that they are in no hurry to give up the top spot after repeating as champion November 17 at Slippery Rock.

With three finishers in the top 10, Western State compiled a team score of 46 points. Adams State, which dropped to fifth place in 2000, moved back up the ladder to second with 55 points.

Hannah Lawrence gave Western State a sweep of the titles, winning the individual championship. She covered the 6,000-meter course in 21:24.7.

Kennesaw State's Marjo Venalainen, the two-time defending champion, nearly became the first three-time winner in NCAA women's cross country championships history. Venalainen was second, 7.1 seconds behind Lawrence.

### Highlights

**Panthers Produce Repeat:** Middlebury increased its winning margin over a familiar opponent as it repeated as champion November 17 at Augustana (Illinois).

The Panthers had a team total of 98 points. Williams finished in the runner-up position for the second straight year with 166 points.

In 2000, Middlebury edged Williams by a single point in the New England regional-qualifying meet and by 20 points in the national event. The Panthers increased their advantage over the Ephs to 11 points in the 2001 regional event and nearly 70 in the championships.

Michela Adrian led the way for Middlebury, placing 10th overall. She covered the 5,000-meter course in 17:27.

Jessica Manzer was 13th for the Panthers, seven seconds behind Adrian, and Molly Tazwinski came in 23rd.

Williams' Jenn Campbell was third and the Ephs' Julia Bensen was sixth.

Dana Boyle of Puget Sound took the lead on a downhill portion of the course late in the race and went on to win the individual title with a time of 16:46.
