

Highlights

Cal State-Monterey Bay captures title; top No. 1 seed Lynn in championship match: Cal State Monterey Bay got a hole-in-one from sophomore Dylan Jackson en route to winning the 2011 NCAA Division II national championship, defeating top seed Lynn 3-2, in the title match at Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail at The Shoals in Alabama on May 20.

Jackson aced the 178-yard, par-3 13th. He also made birdie on the par-3 18th to win his match against Lynn's Ricardo Gouveia, 1-up.

The clinching moment came from Otter senior John Jackson, who sank his final putt on the 18th hole to take a one-stroke lead against Lynn's Daniel Young. That win, coupled with D.J. Milligan's two-stroke victory against Roberto Francioni and Dylan Jackson's one-stroke win against Gouveia gave Cal State Monterey Bay the three points it needed for the program's first national title.

"I am extremely proud of how far this team has come," said Otters third-year head coach Jason Owen. "It is a fitting end for a team that has persevered through everything I have thrown at them. Awesome!"

Lynn earned two points with wins from Paul McPhee and Jose Joia. McPhee defeated Scott Yeakel by two strokes and Joia topped Oskar Nystrom by one stroke.

"I'm extremely proud of our guys," said Lynn head coach Chris Greenwood. "They left everything out there today. All five of our guys shot under par but you have to tip your hat to CSUMB."

The Otters got personal-best rounds from Dylan Jackson and Milligan. Jackson carded a 6-under-par 66 to tie the lowest score posted of the tournament. Milligan tied his best round of collegiate golf with a 3-under-par 69.

This was the sixth consecutive tournament victory for the Otters dating back to March 14, including their first NCAA Central/West Super Regional title and second consecutive California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) championship.

En route to the championship match, the Otters concluded stroke play 17-over-par for a tie for third place. The Otters entered match play as the third seed, defeating Newberry, 3-2, in the opening round. Monterey Bay then pulled out a 2-2-1 tie against Abilene Christian in the semifinals, with the Otters winning the tiebreaker by fewest strokes.
