

Highlights

Methodist wins 14th consecutive title; Final round canceled due to weather; 54-hole scores made final: Mother Nature decided three rounds was enough for Methodist women's golf team in 2011.

The Monarchs held a 12-shot advantage over Gustavus Adolphus when the final round of the Division III championships started May 13 at the Mission Inn and Golf Resort in Howey-in-the-Hills, Fla. Rain and lightning wiped out the final 18 holes with only half of the field finished. Methodist still led by 11 when play was halted, and scores through three rounds played May 10-12 determined the champion.

It was Methodist's 14th consecutive NCAA title, including all 12 Division III championships and the last two when Divisions II and III had a combined championship.

"You always want to finish on the golf course if you can," said second-year Methodist coach Tom Inczauskis. "But we did the work the first three days. We played some great golf on a tough golf course and we were up by 11 going into the back nine during the (fourth) round. I'd like to think we would have hung on.

"It's been a real honor for me to coach such successful ladies. They've done it with (four) different coaches. They are such capable players. Not one of them wants to see it end on their watch."

Methodist senior Paige Caldwell was tied with Centre's Emily Bachert at 17-over when play was stopped. But, entering the final round, Caldwell led by three shots and earned medalist honors a year after finishing second. She shot rounds of 77-76-79. Bachert carded rounds of 80-79-76.

Senior Emily Jackson (85-79-77) finished fifth at 22-over, nine shots behind Caldwell. Gretchen McLean, a third Methodist senior, tied for 14th at 28-over.

Junior Andrea Daley tied for 29th and Kelsie Carralero, the squad's lone underclassman, was 48th.

Gustavus Adolphus, also runner-up in 2010, was led by Katie Schenfeld, who tied for third at 20-over-par with Hannah Buck of Washington U. in St. Louis. Rikka Holiday tied for sixth at 23-over for the Gusties, while Annie Jackson was also among the top 25.

Illinois Wesleyan, Saint Mary's (Indiana) and DePauw rounded out the top 5 in the 19-team field.
