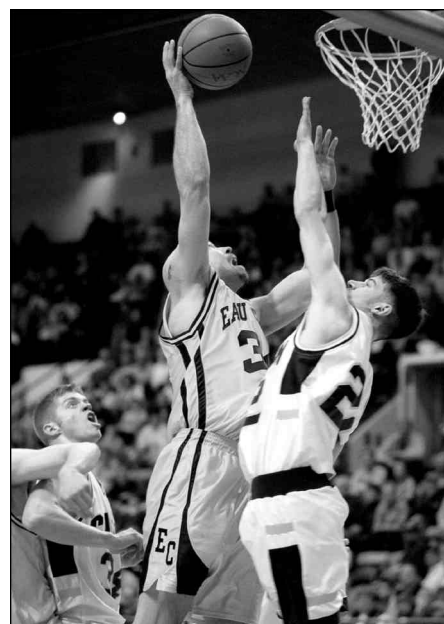


All-tournament pick Jeremy Veenstra of Calvin fends off Wisconsin-Eau Claire's Todd Marks in the title game.
