INDIVIDUAL RECORDS

In statistical rankings, the rounding of percentages and/or averages may indicate ties where none exists. In these cases, the numerical order of the rankings is accurate.

For the 2020-21 season due to COVID-19 pandemic and cancellation of the Division III championship, the minimums for inclusion in the NCAA records book for single-season per game categories and the annual statistical champion was set at 11 games.
