Highlights

Cowboy Up: Oklahoma State ran to its second consecutive team title at the Division I Men's Cross Country Championships on Nov. 22 at the LaVern Gibson Championship Course in Terre Haute, Ind., pulling away to a dominant 120-point victory over Florida State.

The race for the individual title was closer, as Liberty's Samuel Chelanga sped past Arizona's Stephen Sambu on the final straightaway for his second consecutive crown. Chelanga finished the 10-kilometer race in 29 minutes, 22 seconds, nearly 40 seconds slower than last year's time but fast enough to defend his title against Sambu and Oregon's Luke Puskedra.

Meanwhile, all five of Oklahoma State's scoring runners placed among the top 30 team scorers. Girma Mecheso (seventh overall, fifth among team scorers) and German Fernandez (eighth overall, sixth team) led the Cowboys.

The Cowboys moved in front at the 5-kilometer marker and steadily increased their lead through the second half.
