2012 Highlights

North Central wins 15th national crown. For a second consecutive season, North Central (Illinois) persevered over the 32-team field at the NCAA Division III Cross Country Championships November 17, held at the LaVern Gibson Championship Course in Terre Haute, Ind.

North Central was in fifth place after the 7,000-meter mark of the 8,000-meter course, but the Cardinals were able to outlast the field, maneuvering past numerous runners during the final 1,000 meters, en route to its 15th team title.

"We really pulled it out in the last quarter-mile," head coach Al Carius said. "We knew we had to build as the race went on, because it was a tougher course than it appears. We waited until the last second to pull it out, but fortunately that's the way the season has gone."

North Central recorded 167 total team points. Calvin and Haverford tied for second place, each amassing 188 points. Wisconsin-La Crosse placed fourth with 190 points and Washington U. in St. Louis rounded out the top five (226).

Junior John Crain paced the Cardinals with a sixth-place individual finish, crossing the tape in 24:43.5. Dan Kerley was the next Cardinal to finish, ending his career with a 14th-place effort in a time of 24:48.5.

Roger Klein finished the race in 25:12.2, good for 44th place, while Yonatan Mascote finished close behind in 50th place, crossing the tape in 25:17.40.

"We knew the course was going to be tough, so the two things we preached [Saturday] were patience and confidence," Crain said. "The first loop we wanted to be patient and the second lap we wanted confidence to finish off and stay strong through the whole race."

"That's how we've been racing this year and somehow we finished it out with determination."

Tim Nelson of Wisconsin-Stout claimed the individual championship, completing the course in a time of 24:26.8. He finished eight seconds ahead of runner-up Bobby Over of Allegheny.

North Central is the only school to appear in all 40 NCAA Division III Men's Cross Country Championships and has finished among the top four 36 times.
