2012 Highlights

Adams State wins its NCAA-record ninth national championship: Led by three Grizzlies who were among the top four finishers, Adams State won its NCAA Division II-record ninth and 21st overall national title November 17 at Missouri Southern State.

The Grizzlies had five of the top 15 finishers and had all seven runners place in the top 28 en route to a team score of just 34 points. Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference rival Colorado Mines was second with 102 points. Alaska Anchorage took third with 147, led by individual champion Micah Chelimo.

Augustana (South Dakota) placed fourth with 182 points to edge Cal State Chico by one point.

Chelimo finished the 10,000-meter course in a time of 28 minutes, 56.6 seconds before Adams State redshirt freshman Kevin Batt out-raced sophomore teammate Tabor Stevens by a tenth of a second for the runner-up spot. Grizzly sophomore Matt Daniels, part of the lead pack throughout, finished fourth.

Grizzly senior David Sanchez finished 12th in 29:49.6 before sophomore John Luterbach completed the team title with a 16th place finish in 29:57.0.

Senior Andrew Roberts and junior Jovanny Godinez also showcased the Grizzlies' impressive depth as they finished 25th and 28th with times of 30:09.6 and 30:10.1, respectively.

Senior David Sanchez finished 12th for the champions before sophomore John Luterbach completed the team title with a 16th-place finish.

Batt, Stevens and Daniels were all a part of a lead pack of 11 that separated from the field in the early going. That pack was gradually whittled down, but was never without the Grizzlies' front three until Chelimo pulled away down the stretch to claim the Seawolves' first individual championship.

The Grizzlies, who posted the championships' largest margin of victory since the meet was also held at Missouri Southern State in 1999, have won four of the last five Division II titles. Their ninth crown enabled them to move past Western State for the most in Division II history.

Adams State also won an NAIA-record 12 titles before moving to the Division II ranks in 1992.
