2013 Highlights

Colorado comes from behind to capture fourth national title: Colorado captured its fourth national championship in school history, coming from behind throughout the race to end up on top in cold and windy conditions at the LaVern Gibson Cross Country Course.

The Buffs were 10th as a team at the 3 kilometers split and then made their move. By the halfway point at 5 kilometers, the Buffs were third, and at the 8 kilometer split, they were up to second and closing on Northern Arizona. By the time all the dust settled, the Buffs knocked off Northern Arizona by 20 points.

It's the Buffs' first national championship since 2006, and the Buffs now have six overall cross country titles, including two women's titles, all coming under coach Mark Wetmore.

True freshman Ben Saarel led the Buffs with an eighth-place finish, becoming the first true freshman All-American for Colorado since assistant coach and Olympian Billy Nelson finished 20th in 2002. Saarel's final time was 30:14.1 and he moved up throughout the race, including three spots in the final 2 kilometers of the race.

Another freshman, Oregon's Edward Cheserek, also had an outstanding day, claiming the individual championship in 29:41.1. He was followed by senior Kennedy Kithuka of Texas Tech, who finished in 29:59.1, and senior Maksim Korolev of Harvard, with a time of 29:59.5.

Northern Arizona came in as team the runner-up with 169 points.
