- On February 9, 1895, the first game was played between two college teams as the University of Minnesota School of Agriculture defeated Hamline, 9-3. However, nine players were allowed on the court at the same time for both teams. Also, the Agriculture School included students of both college and high-school age. So many people say that game doesn't count.
- The first college basketball game with five players on a side was played January 18, 1896, when the University of Chicago defeated the University of Iowa, 15-12, in Iowa City. Both teams' starting five played the entire game. However, Iowa's starters comprised a YMCA team who all were students at the university, so does this game count as a true college game?
- And finally, some basketball historians say that the first true collegiate men's game was played between Yale University and the University of Pennsylvania in February 1897. Yale defeated Pennsylvania, 32-10.
