Although P.J. Carlesimo scored no points for Fordham in three games of the 1971 NCAA tournament, he had better success as a coach. As the only bearded coach to make the Final Four, Carlesimo led Seton Hall to six tournament appearances from 1988 to 1994, including a runner-up spot at the Final Four in 1989.

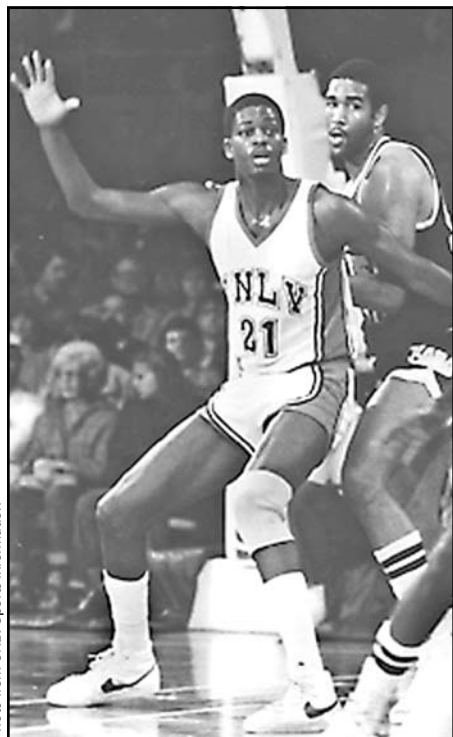

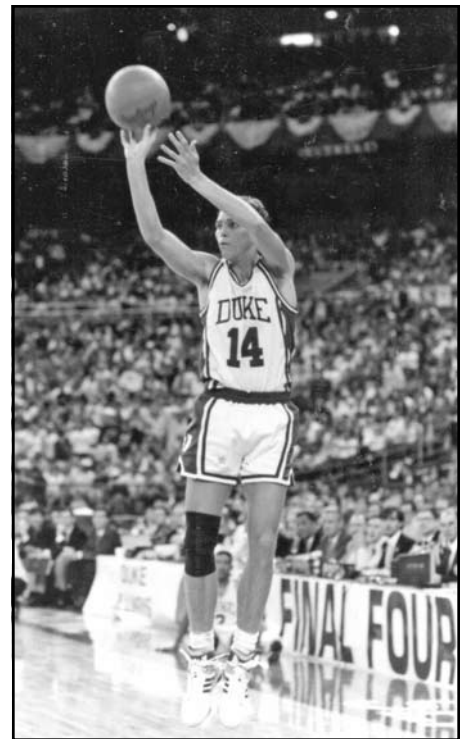

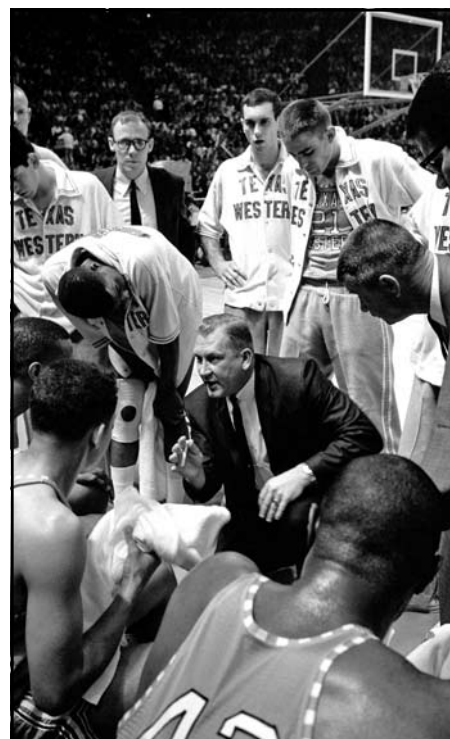

By the way, Steve Krafcsin is the only other player to play in two Final Fours for two different schools. Krafcsin played for North Carolina in 1977 and Iowa in 1980.

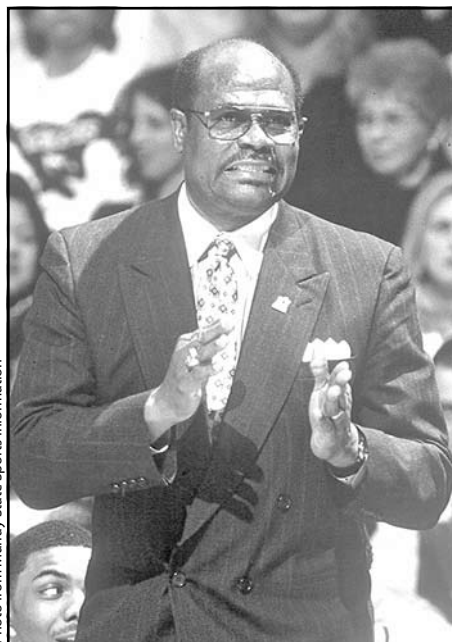

After three tournament appearances with Western Kentucky from 2001-03, coach Dennis Felton went on to Georgia, where he led the Bulldogs to a highly unlikely NCAA tournament appearance in 2008. Georgia had finished last in the Eastern Division of the Southeastern Conference with a 4-12 record. In the SEC tournament, the Bulldogs had to overcome a 6-seed out of six teams in their division and 12 teams in the tournament, and survived a mid-tournament tornado that ripped through the Georgia Dome and caused a change of venue to the Georgia Tech campus. If that wasn't enough, Georgia had to play two games in one day and won them both to take the SEC automatic bid.

Elmer Gross was the first NCAA tournament player to later coach a team into the tournament. Gross played for Penn State in the 1942 tournament and coached his alma mater to tournament appearances in 1952 and 1954.

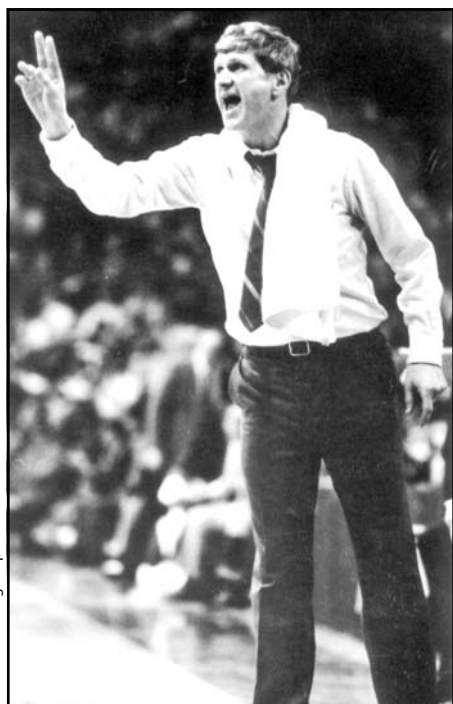

Assistant Steve Fisher took over the Wolverines coaching duties and led them to six straight tournament wins and a national championship.

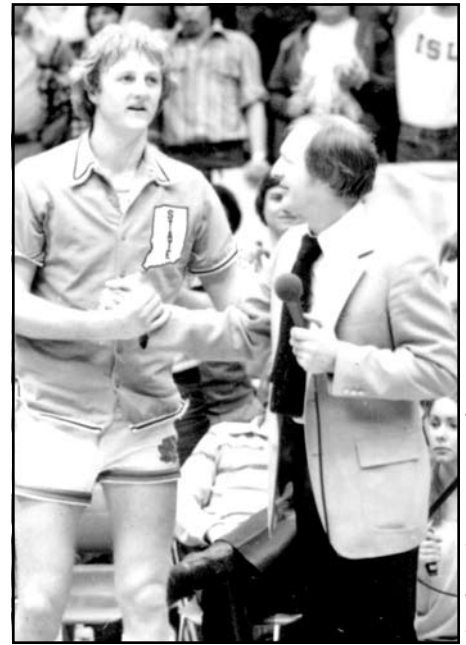

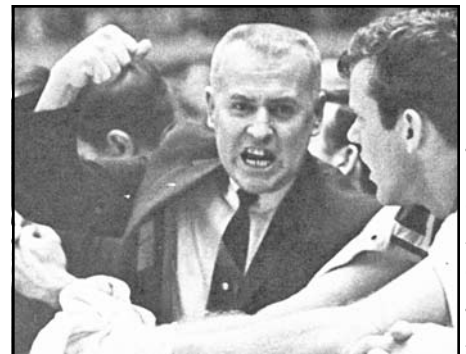

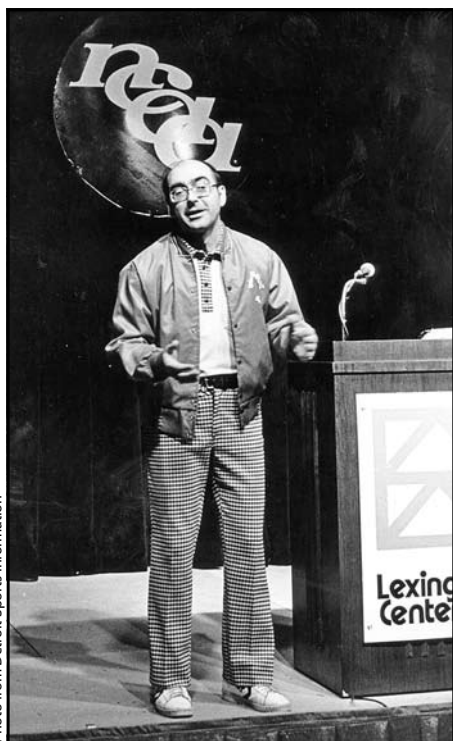
