April 7, 2008, Final Four at the Alamodome in San Antonio – In what has become known as “Mario’s Miracle,” Kansas Jayhawk Mario Chalmers made a last-ditch three-point basket against Memphis to tie the 2008 championship game and send it into overtime. The Jayhawks went on to win, 75-68, in what some fans consider one of the most exciting championship games in several years. Memphis held a nine-point lead with 2:12 left in regulation, but Kansas stormed back, capitalizing on some missed Memphis free throws down the stretch to set up Chalmers, the Final Four Most Outstanding Player, for his game-saving shot.
