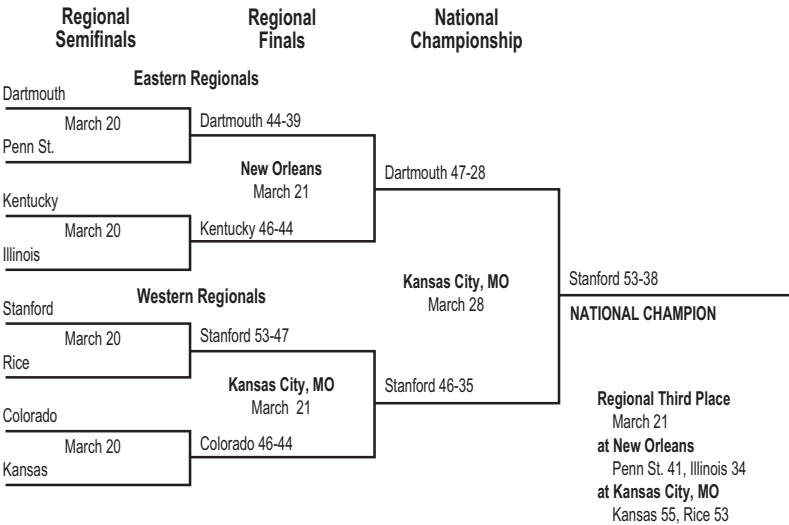
1940 Championship Bracket



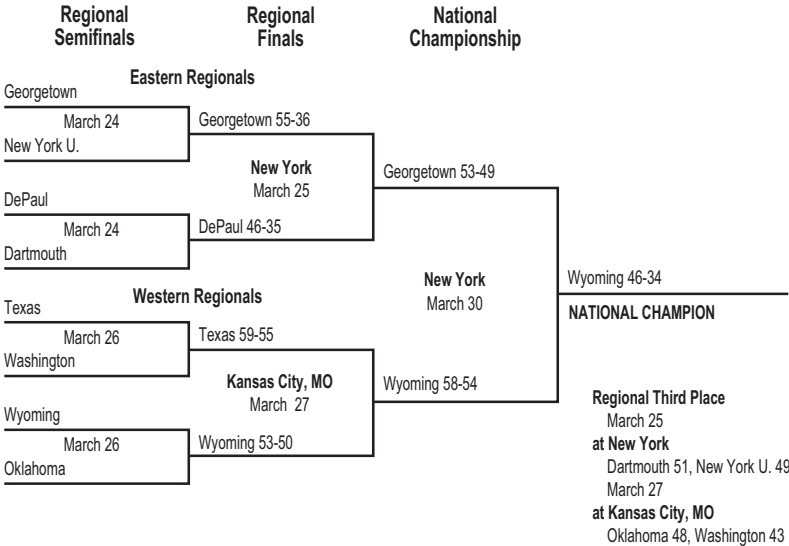

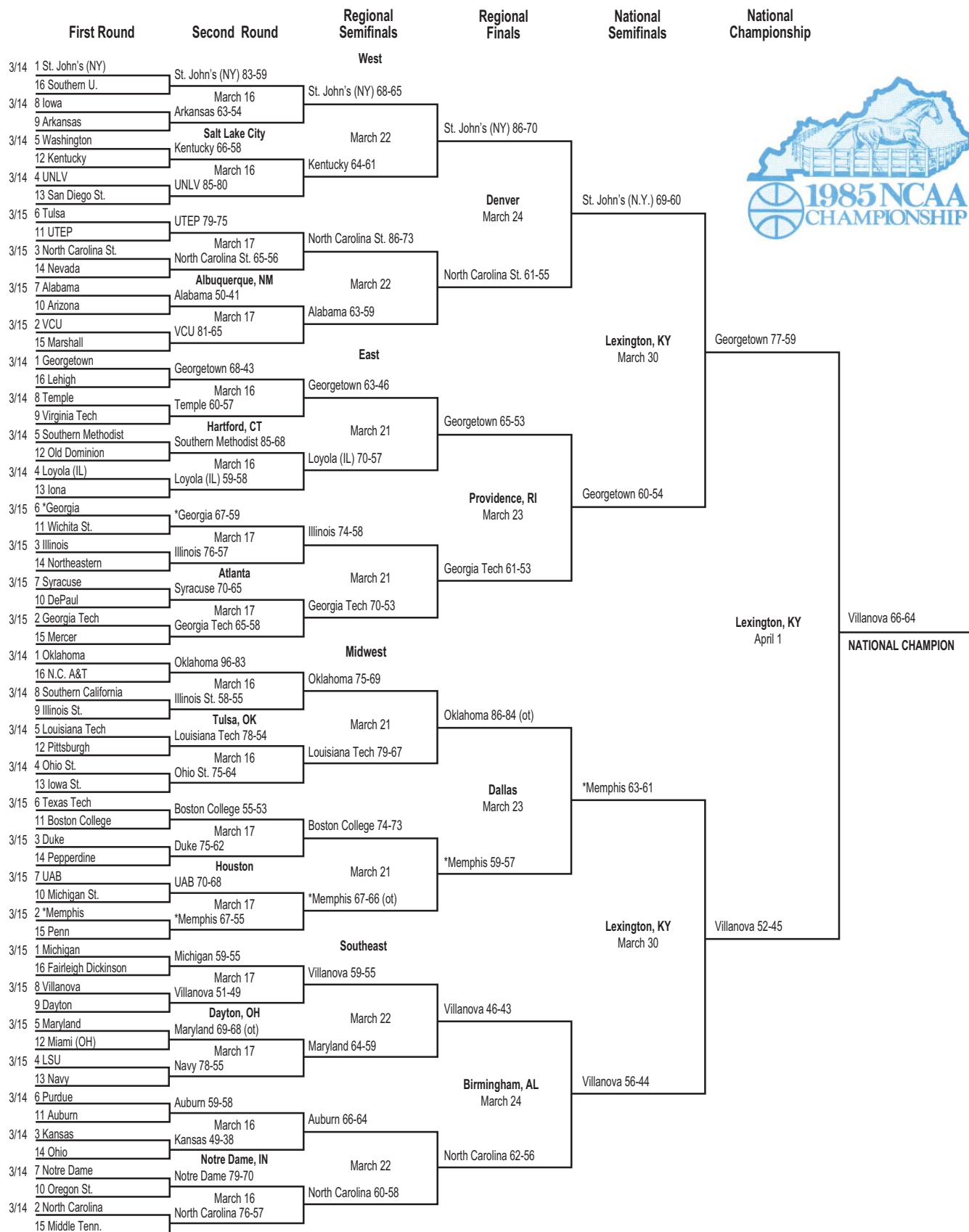

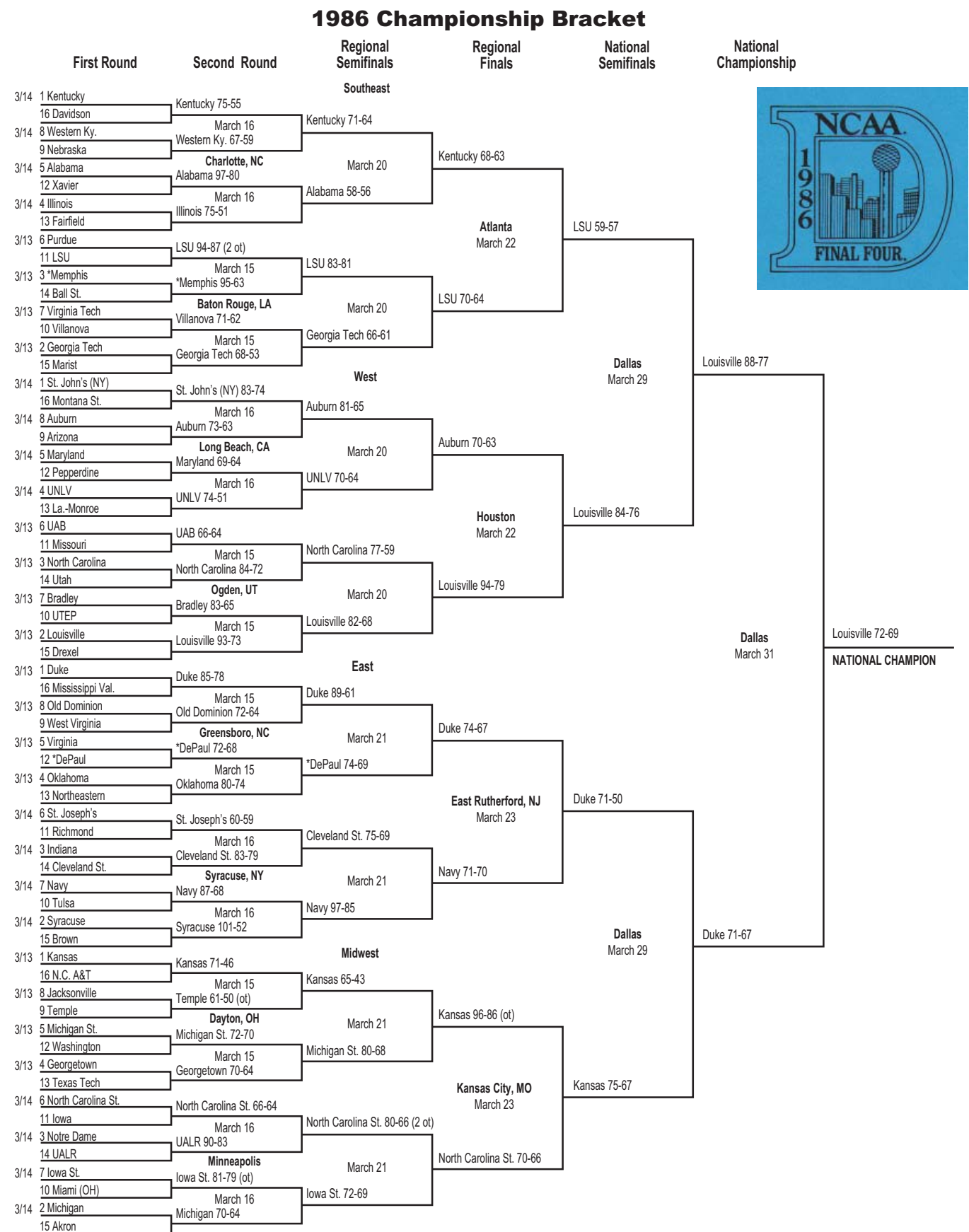

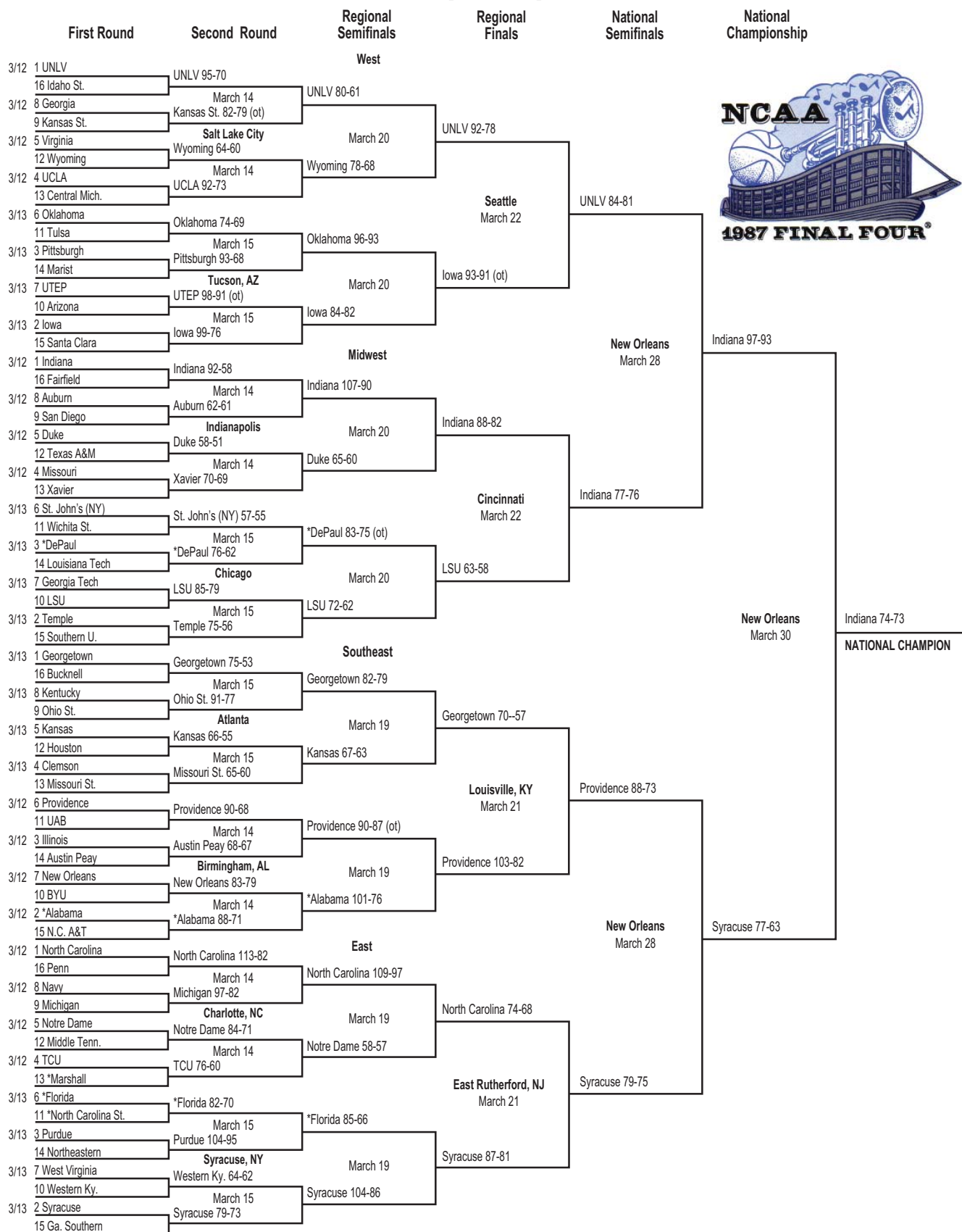

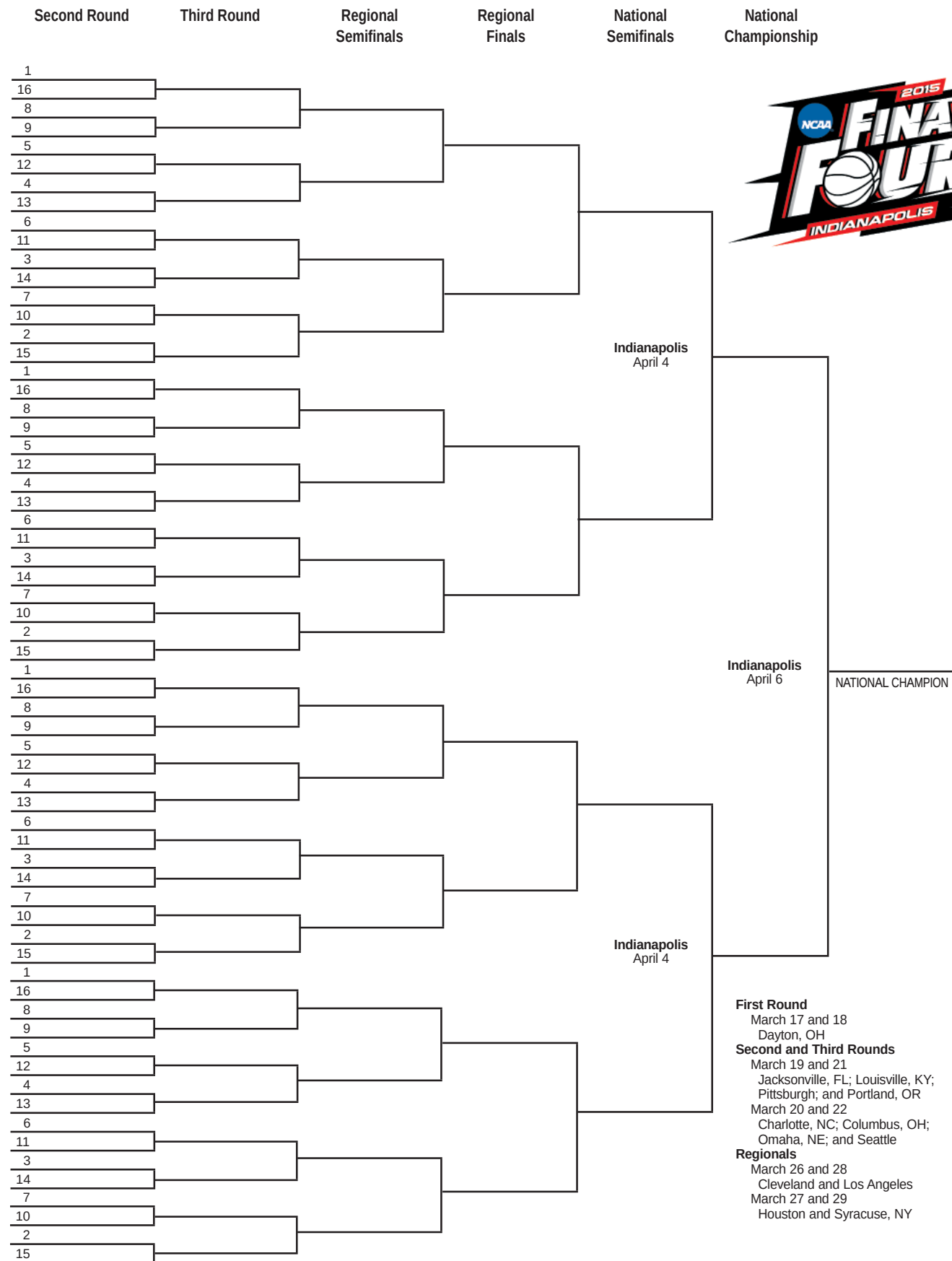
