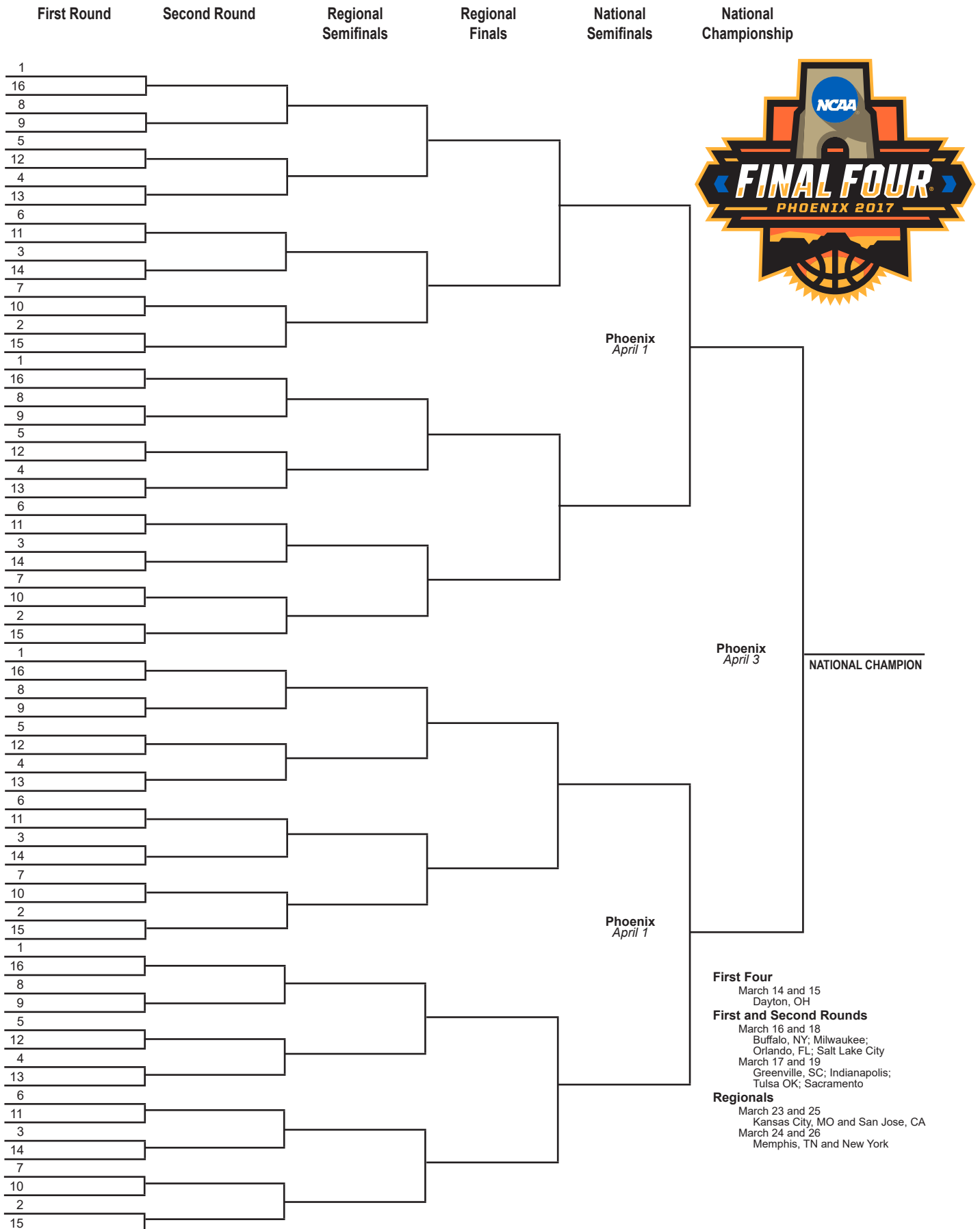
2015 Championship Bracket
