2007 Highlights

Oswego State Edges Middlebury for First Team Championship: Oswego State battled through two consecutive overtime games to take the Division III Men's Ice Hockey Championship, 4-3, over defending champion Middlebury March 18 in Superior, Wis. Garren Reisweber scored 12:55 into overtime to push the Lakers past the Panthers for the school's first team championship in any sport.

Lakers goaltender Ryan Scott, a junior who set an Division III championship-game record with 47 saves, recorded 19 in the first period alone.

After a scoreless first period, the teams traded goals in a wild second stanza. Reisweber scored just 33 seconds into the period on an assist from Peter Magagna. Consecutive Middlebury goals by Jamie McKenna and John Sales put the Panthers up, 2-1. Trevor Gilligan evened the game at 2 for the Lakers by putting a puck through the legs of Middlebury goalie Ross Cherry at 16:12 into the second. Mark Lozzi and Darrell Levy assisted on that score.

The Lakers took a 3-2 lead 5:33 into the third on a power-play notch by Magagna with Brendan McLaughlin assisting. But the Panthers put on heavy pressure, finally resulting in the tying tally off the stick of John Sullivan with 2:25 remaining in regulation.

Overtime saw the two teams trade scoring chances. Finally, Reisweber took a McLaughlin feed near center ice and eluded two Panther defenders, faked to Cherry's left, then skated through to tuck the puck into the other side of the net to give the Laker ice hockey team -- and the college athletics program -- its first national championship.

"Our guys all year long have found a way to gut it out and hang in there. Tonight was no exception. They played extremely hard and smart," Oswego State head coach Ed Gosek said. "It's an unbelievable feeling."

The national championship feeling didn't come easily for Oswego State (23-3-3), which had to overcome fatigue from its 4-3 overtime win over St. Norbert in the semifinals the day before the nearly three-hour championship game. Even Reisweber noted that he was starting to feel weary before his game-winning shot.

Middlebury, which ended the year 20-8-3, came into the championship game on a 10-game unbeaten streak after starting the season off uncharacteristically slowly. The Panthers had won the last three national titles in shutouts, but lost six games in the first half of the season before coming into their own in the second half.
