# Individual Records

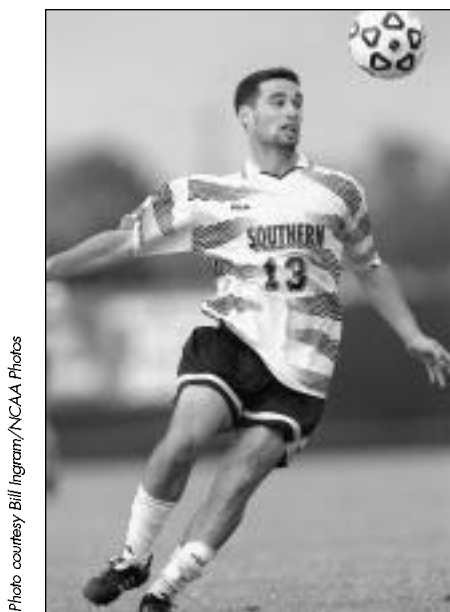
