

Division III Men's Records

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Individual Records

Career records of players include only those years in which they competed in Division III. Annual champions started in the 1998 season, which was the first year the NCAA compiled weekly leaders. 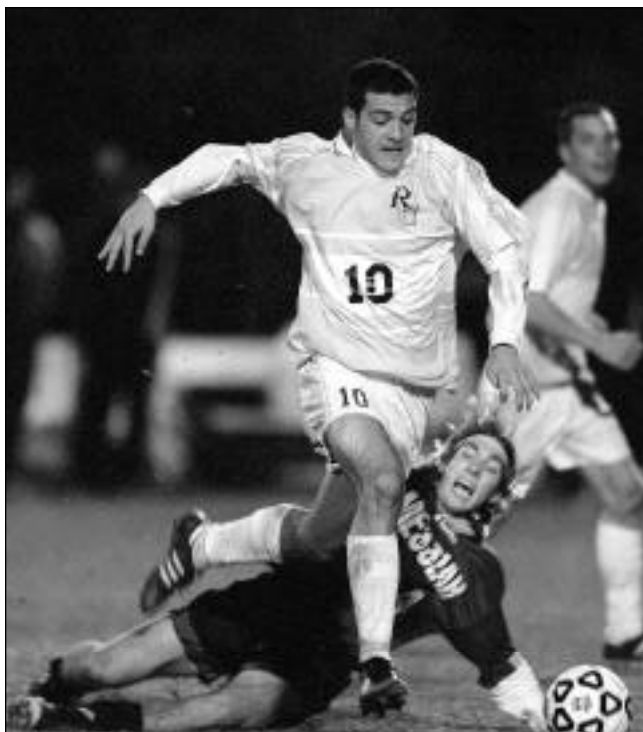
