All-America Teams

NOTE: The All-America teams were selected by the various team captains of the Intercollegiate Association Football League for the 1909-10 season. Various team managers selected the team from the 1910-11 season until 1917. No teams were selected in 1918 or 1919 due to World War I. From 1926 to 1940, the teams were selected by coaches from the Intercollegiate Soccer Football Association. From 1936 to 1940, there was no single All-America team; instead, the teams were selected by districts. In 1941, William Jeffrey of Penn St. and Richard Schmelzer of Rensselaer selected the team. Since 1942, the National Soccer Coaches Association of America has selected the team. Seasons were played in spring from 1910 to 1914.
