# INDIVIDUAL RECORDS

Official NCAA Division II men's soccer records began with the 1959 season and are based on information submitted to the NCAA statistics service by institutions participating in the statistics rankings. Career records of players include only those years in which they competed in Division II. Annual champions started in the 1998 season, which was the first year the NCAA compiled weekly leaders. In statistical rankings, the rounding of percentages and/or averages may indicate ties where none exists. In these cases, the numerical order of the rankings is accurate.

The 2020 season was split between the fall and spring of 2020-21, and the Division II championship was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The minimum number of matches played during the 2020 season for record book inclusion in single-season per game categories was six games, which was the minimum required for at-large NCAA championship consideration in Division I. Statistical champions were not recognized due to the overall lack of participation across the division.

# TEAM RECORDS

Official NCAA Division II men's soccer records began with the 1959 season and are based on information submitted to the NCAA statistics service by institutions participating in the statistics rankings. Annual champions started in the 1998 season, which was the first year the NCAA compiled weekly leaders. In statistical rankings, the rounding of percentages and/or averages may indicate ties where none exists. In these cases, the numerical order of the rankings is accurate.

The 2020 season was split between the fall and spring of 2020-21, and the Division III championship was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The minimum number of matches played during the 2020 season for record book inclusion in single-season per game categories was six games, which was the minimum required for at-large NCAA championship consideration in Division I. Statistical champions were not recognized due to the overall lack of participation across the division.
