Highlights

Williams clinches sixth consecutive Division III national championship, seventh overall: Williams captured its sixth consecutive team title at the Division III Women's Rowing Championships on May 28 on Lake Natoma at the Sacramento State Aquatic Center in Gold River, California.

Williams' first varsity eights crew capture the grand final in a time of 6 minutes, 54.43 seconds, more than six seconds ahead of second-place Bates. It marked Williams' third straight varsity eights title and secured the team championship for the Ephs.

Bates claimed national runner-up status for the third straight year. The Bobcats' first varsity eights was second to Williams in the grand final for the third straight year, as well. Wellesley's third-place showing was the best in the school's athletics history, matching the volleyball team's finish in 1998.
