Highlights

Vermont's valiant effort earns crown; Catamounts earn 832 points, most by an NCAA champion: Vermont won its first National Collegiate Men's and Women's Skiing Championships team title since 1994 and sixth in the program's history March 10, 2012, after the alpine ski team wrapped up a stellar performance with a 1-2-5 finish in the women's slalom and a 2-7 finish in the men's slalom at Bridger Bowl in Bozeman, Mont.

"It was an incredible effort by the entire team. They put together an awesome week to earn this," said Bill Reichelt, Vermont's director of skiing and head alpine coach. "The Nordic team did an unbelievable job yesterday and set the alpine team up in strong position going into today. Coaches Patrick [Weaver] and Andrew [Johnson] nailed the wax both days for the Nordic team and the kids were amazing," continued Reichelt.

"We had a great feeling going into the last day. The girls were conservative on the first run, but stepped it up for the second run. To finish 1-2-5 in the slalom at the NAAs is pretty incredible," said Reichelt.

Vermont piled up 832 points, the most by a NCAA champion, and won by a record-breaking 161 points over Utah. Colorado, the defending NCAA champion, moved up to third on the last day with 670 points.

The Catamounts built a 92-point lead against top-ranked Utah after an outstanding effort by the Nordic squad in the classic races March 9.

Senior Amy Glen won the women's 15-kilometer classic in a photo finish and the women went 1-3-5 in the event. Senior Franz Bernstein added a third-place finish in the men's 20-kilometer classic to help set the table for the alpine team on Saturday.

Sophomore Kate Ryley set the pace early with a time of 43.76 in her first run and won the race with a two-run total of 1:35.17, 17 tenths-of-a-second faster than her teammate Kristina Riis-Johannessen. Ryley is the first Catamount to win an individual title in the women's slalom since Gibson LaFountaine won back-to-back championships in 1993 and 1994.

Ryley was the runner-up in the giant slalom to earn first-team All-America honors in both events for the second consecutive year.

In the men's slalom, Vermont's Tim Kelley, the defending champion, missed out on a repeat title by 24 tenths-of-a-second. Denver's Epsen Lysdahl won the event with a time of 1:48.28. Kelley was the runner-up and placed fourth in the giant slalom.

Utah was led by individual champions Maria Graefnings in the women's 5-kilometer freestyle cross country and Miles Havlick in the 20-kilometer classical cross country. Graefnings won for the second consecutive year.

The other individual winners were Northern Michigan's Erik Soderman (men's 10-kilometer freestyle cross country), Colorado's Adam Zika (men's giant slalom) and Harvard's Rebecca Nadler (women's giant slalom).
