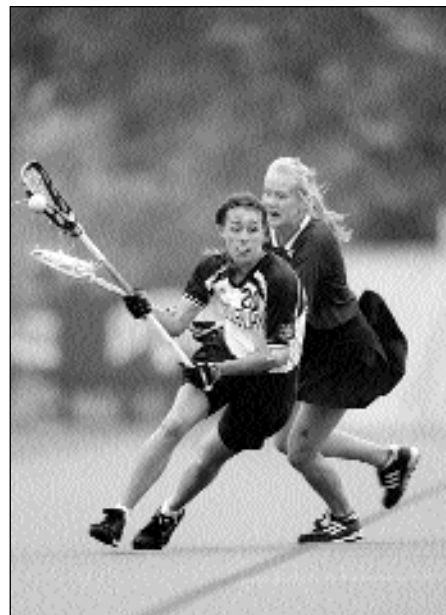
Highlights

Panthers Comeback: Undeclared Middlebury rallied from a six-goal, second-half deficit to beat Amherst, 11-10, in overtime, as the Panthers won their third title in the last five years. The winning score came from Betsy Wheeler, her third goal of the game, 24 seconds into the first extra period. Middlebury's victory made it the fourth straight year that the championship team was undefeated.
