2001 Championships

Highlights

Falcons Follow Indoor Title With Outdoor Crown: St. Augustine's swept the 2001 titles by winning the championship May 24-26 at Southern Illinois-Edwardsville.

The Falcons earned 80 to 59 for second-place and two-time defending champion Abilene Christian. The title was St. Augustine's ninth outdoors and marked the sixth year in which it has won both track and field championships.

Tim Rusan sparked St. Augustine's effort by winning both the long jump and triple jump. Marquis Davis also was a key contributor to the winners by placing second in both the 100- and 200-meter dashes.

Abilene Christian was led by John Kemboi and Alfred Rugema. Kemboi won both the 800- and 1,500-meter runs for the second consecutive year. Rugema was second to his teammate in the 1,500 and also was the runner-up in the 5,000-meter run.

Rusan and Kemboi were among five athletes who won two events in the championship. New York Tech's Orville Taylor was first in the 200- and 400-meter dashes, Western State's Michael Aish captured the 5,000- and 10,000-meter runs, and Angelo State's Curry Dawson swept the shot put and discus titles.

Central Missouri State's Vladimir Golias won the 3,000-meter steeplechase for the fourth straight year. He is just the second athlete in the championships' 39-year history to win the same event four times.
