2001 Championship

Highlights

Rollins Returns: One chapter closed and another began in Division II men's tennis. Lander, winner of eight championships, failed to advance out of the quarterfinals and opened the door for a different champion. Rollins took advantage, and with a 5-0 win over Hawaii Pacific, captured its fourth national tennis title.

The Tars swept the doubles to take a commanding lead in the finals. Matt Porter and Goran Sterijovski won, 8-6, at No. 1 doubles; Mark Thompson and Drew Sipka won, 9-7, at the No. 2 spot; and Andrew Grosilmond and Brandon Smith claimed an 8-4 victory at the No. 3 position.

Smith was the first to finish in singles play and claimed a 6-1, 6-3 victory at the No. 4 position. Porter, at the No. 1 spot, defeated the top player in Division II tennis, Mikael Maatta, to earn the final point needed for the title.
