Highlights

Cardinal Wins Crown: The Stanford Cardinal topped the Vanderbilt Commodores 4-0 in Stone Mountain, Georgia, to capture their 11th national crown. The squad finished the season with an unblemished record for the seventh time in program history.

Stanford outscored six NCAA opponents 24-1 during its title run and has won 76 of its last 77 matches over the past three seasons. Vanderbilt made its first NCAA tennis final appearance in school history.

In the individual competitions, Stanford's Laura Granville, captured her second consecutive singles title, 7-6, 6-3 over teammate Lauren Kalvaria.

Granville came close to making NCAA tournament history by sweeping all three championship titles in a single year. She and doubles partner Lastra lost 6-4, 1-6, 3-6 in the doubles final to Florida's Whitney Laiho and Jessica Lehnhoff.
