Highlights

Bruins Upset Host's Hopes: UCLA's Coralie Simmons scored with 1:28 remaining in the first National Collegiate Women's Water Polo Championship to give the Bruins a 5-4 win and hand host Stanford its first loss of the season.

UCLA (19-4) claimed its fifth national title in six years, although this was the first NCAA title. The Bruins had faced Stanford, which finished the season 27-1, four times before the national championship and had previously been unable to win.

The Cardinal scored first on a power-play goal from Brenda Villa, and UCLA answered with two goals before the end of the first period. Simmons scored with 4:59 remaining in the second quarter to build the Bruins' lead to 3-1. Villa scored again before halftime, though, to close the gap to 3-2.

In the fourth quarter, Stanford was able to knot the score at 4-4 with 3:27 remaining in the game before Simmons found herself with an opportunity in the waning moments. After a few fakes, she scored the game-winner.

The Cardinal had a final shot on goal, but Villa's attempt was blocked with :20 remaining.

All-Tournament Team: Simmons was named the tournament's most outstanding player and was joined on the all-tournament squad by teammates Robin Beauregard and Kelly Heuchan. Brenda Villa, Jackie Frank and Ellen Estes were honored for the Cardinal, along with Loyola Marymount's Lucy Windes.



UCLA scored its championship-winning goal with 1:28 left. Senior Coralie Simmons was named the tournament's most outstanding player for the clutch score.
