Highlights

Gopher Heaven: Minnesota did more than make the cut—it won the title.

The Gophers shot a six-under-par 278 on the final day of competition for a 1,134 total and a four-stroke victory over top-ranked Georgia Tech. The championship was conducted at Ohio State's Scarlet Golf Course.

Minnesota, ranked no higher than 18th in the national polls, became the first Northern school to win the championship since Ohio State won in 1979.

Weather problems threatened the field of 30 teams to be cut in half after 36 holes, which would have included cutting Minnesota, since the Gophers were 16th. But a third-round 283 vaulted Minnesota to a fourth-place tie heading into the final round.

Individually, Georgia Tech's Troy Matteson was the medalist, shooting one stroke better than TCU's Adam Rubinson. Hunter Mahan of Oklahoma State was third. Matteson is Georgia Tech's first individual champion.
