Highlights

Drury secures national title with depth and pride: Drury powered away from the field to claim its eighth straight title as the four-day 2012 NCAA Division II Swimming and Diving Championships came to a close March 17 at the Mansfield (Texas) ISD Natatorium.

Drury amassed 473 points to easily outdistance runner-up UC San Diego (400) and third-place Florida Southern (316½). The eight consecutive titles by the Panthers equals the run by CSU Bakersfield from 1986 to 1993 as the longest in Division II history. Drury's 10th title overall moves the Panthers closer to Bakersfield's Division II record of 13 championships.

Of the 19 men's titles combined at the NAIA and NCAA Division II levels won by Drury coach Brian Reynolds, this one might be a tad more satisfying because there were indications before the season that the team might not be championships contenders.

The Panthers were weakened entering the 2011-12 season when senior-to-be Jun Han Kim decided to take a year off and train for a shot at making South Korea's 2012 Olympic team. That was a huge blow, considering Kim was a star in the past two national meets, earning NCAA Swimmer of the Year honors as a sophomore in 2010. Vladimir Sidorkin decided to stay in Florida for the first semester and chase his own Olympic hopes.

The tide began to turn in Drury's direction when Sidorkin returned for the spring semester. The Panthers also added reinforcements after the semester break in freshmen Oleksandr Padalkin and Kacper Pelzynski.

While Drury won just two events – the 200- and 400-yard freestyle relays – they placed in most. Sidorkin placed second in the 100-yard freestyle, third in the 50 free and fourth in the 200 free; Padalkin was fifth in the 100 free and ninth in the 200. The two were on both winning relay teams.

Drury took a 23-point lead over second-place UC San Diego into the final day of competition, and by the time the morning preliminaries were completed – during which the Panthers qualified a barrage of swimmers in the 100 free and other races – Drury could smell another title.

Junior Ryan Arabejo kicked off the evening session with a second-place finish in the 1,650-yard freestyle. Seniors Jason Bell and Mark Grijalva came in eighth and 14th, respectively, in the same event as the Panthers compiled 31 points and began to pull away from UC San Diego.

Andrey Seryy of Wayne State (Michigan) was a repeat winner in the 50-, 100-, and 200-yard freestyle events, setting meet records in the 100 (42.61) and 200 (1:35.05, set leading off the 800-yard freestyle relay). Wingate's Iaroslav Denysenko repeated in the 500-yard freestyle with a meet-record 4:21.48, and also won the 1,000- and 1,650-yard freestyle events.
