Highlights

Barry wins first national title; rallies in singles after facing doubles deficit: A day after the 2011 NCAA Division II Women's Tennis Championship final was suspended due to inclement weather, Barry overcame a 2-1 doubles deficit to defeat Lynn, 5-3, May 15 in Altamonte Springs, Florida.

It is the first NCAA championship for the Buccaneers as Barry finished the season with a 25-1 record.

Barry opened its match with Lynn by dropping two of three doubles contests.

Despite facing an early deficit, Lynn's Magdalena Ekert and Isabell Raich controlled their match with Alex Gwizdowski and Laura Boguet, downing the duo 8-5 in the second doubles match.

At No. 1 doubles, Lynn's grouping of Eleonora Iannozzi and Ioana Ivan held a significant advantage against Barbi Pocza and Angie Werschel going into the weather delay. However, the Barry duo was revitalized the next morning and made up four games and nipped the Lynn pair, 8-6.

With Lynn and Barry splitting the first two doubles matches, Lynn got the upper hand when Jessica Yanoff and Andrea Berkova staved off Julie Stas and Olivia Matuszak, 8-4, at the No. 3 spot.

Lynn, needing only three singles victories to win the title, dealt with a refocused and re-energized Barry squad in singles.

The Buccaneers claimed early control of the singles portion, taking a 3-2 lead behind the efforts of the sixth and third spots. Mona Mansour breezed past her opponent 6-0, 6-1, at No. 6, before Caroline Wendling posted the identical scores in her match victory over Raich at the third position.

The Fighting Knights, sensing the match slipping away, responded with a point at No. 2 to knot the score at three when Iannozzi dumped Werschel in straight sets, 6-2 and 6-1.

Coming down to the final three matches, each confrontation was nip and tuck. Matuszak sided the fourth point to Barry as she posted a 6-4, 6-0 win against Ivan at No. 4 singles.

Both No. 1 and No. 5 singles featured a pair of three-set thrillers, but it was the Buccaneers' Pocza who, after splitting the first two sets with Ekert, took the fifth and deciding tally 6-0, 3-6, 6-3.
