Highlights

High five; Williams holds off Chicago and wins fifth consecutive title: Williams became the first Division III tennis team, male or female, to win five consecutive NCAA championships May 23 when it defeated Chicago, 5-2, at the Cary Tennis Center in Cary, N.C.

Eph seniors Kristin Alotta, Caroline Capute and Taylor French ended their collegiate careers with four national titles in four seasons. Williams is now 7-2 in national championship matches and is the first Division III school to win seven women's tennis titles. The present streak of five has been accomplished under head coach Alison Swain, who was a member of Williams' first championship team in 2001.

The Ephs improved to 24-2 with the victory. The Maroons completed their season with a 23-5 record.

Williams held a 2-1 lead over Chicago after doubles play. Alotta and Kathleen Elkins were the first to finish when they extended a 4-3 pro-set lead to 7-4, dropped a game and finished with an 8-5 victory at No. 2 against Chicago's Jennifer Kung and Linden Li.

Capute and Rebecca Curran won a key point at third doubles in a tiebreaker. The duo trailed 6-7, but rallied for two game wins and served for match point before seeing their Maroon counterparts Kelsey McGillis and Megan Tang battle back to tie the set, 8-8. The Eph tandem jumped out to a 4-1 lead in the tiebreaker, saw McGillis and Tang close to 4-3 and 5-4 before winning the last two points – the final coming on a nice overhand smash at the net by Capute – to win the tiebreaker, 7-4.

Chicago tied the match at 2-2 when Kung defeated Kara Shoemaker in straight sets, 6-1, 6-3, in No. 2 singles. Alotta won at No. 1 to recapture the lead for the Ephs. After dropping the first two games of the first set against Kendra Higgins, the Eph senior stormed back to take a 3-2 lead. It was 3-3 before Alotta won two quick games and eventually took the first set, 6-4. Alotta dominated the second set as she won the first three games and cruised to a 6-4, 6-2 victory.

Elkins, a sophomore, upped the Williams' lead to 4-2 when she completed a 6-4, 6-1 win against Li at No. 4 singles.

That left three matches on the courts, with the Ephs needing one more victory for a fifth consecutive championship. Both Capute at No. 5 and freshman Maria Pylypiv at No. 6 won their first sets while Nancy Worley lost her first set at No. 3, 7-5.

Capute jumped out to a quick 2-1 lead in her second set while Pylypiv fell behind, 3-1. Pylypiv trailed 4-2 and 5-4 before tying the set at five and breaking McGillis for a 6-5 lead. Serving for the match, Pylypiv jumped out to a 30-0 lead before closing her 7-5, 7-5 win and clinching the championship for Williams.

Gabrielle Clark of Emory earned the individual singles crown, defeating Middlebury's Lok-Sze Leung in straight sets. Gabby Devlin of Amherst was a member of the champion doubles tandem for the second consecutive year, teaming with Laura Danzig to defeat the Emory pair of Clark and Zahra Dawson. Devlin and Jordan Brewer won the doubles title for Amherst in 2011.
