

Highlights

Williams clinches sixth straight title: Improvement best explains Williams' sixth NCAA championship season in a row.

The Ephs claimed their sixth consecutive Division III Women's Tennis Championships team title May 22, defeating Emory, 5-2, at the Markin Center, Kalamazoo's indoor tennis facility.

Asked what separated this championship team from the five before it, Williams coach Alison Swain and senior co-captains Nancy Worley and Veranika Li said the same thing – improvement.

"This was really unlikely this season," said Swain, who has coached the Ephs to all six of their most recent titles. "We were really, really deep last year and really talented and this year of our 10 players, six are underclassmen and we only have one senior in the lineup.

"Two months ago, this was not a possibility for us," Swain said. "These women improved their game and they improved their mental toughness. This is the most improved team I have ever coached. The amount of pride I feel for these girls is difficult to describe. To do the unbelievable is hard to explain. I am in disbelief."

Williams trailed Emory, 2-1, after doubles play. Emory's Annette Sullivan and Gabrielle Cark defeated Rebecca Curran and Kara Shoemaker, 9-8 (6), at No. 1. Williams' Kathleen Elkins and Maria Pylypiv defeated Emory's Madison Gordon and Jordan Wylie, 8-5, at No. 2, while the Eagles' Brenna Kelly and Emma Taylor beat Worley and Monica Pastor, 8-4, at No. 3.

"Each one is just as exciting as the others, but in a different way," Worley said of the four national championship teams she played on. "We have never had more improvement that this year, though. A lot of things needed to get done in the last two months and we got better and better every week.

"We always emphasize playing for each other and playing with heart and everyone played their best tennis under the most pressure. Being behind after doubles was nothing new to us and we know Emory is a tough team, but we usually come out strong in singles."

Williams earned straight-set singles victories from Elkins at No. 2, Worley at No. 4 and Pylypiv at No. 5. Curran bounced back from dropping a first-set tiebreaker at No. 3.

"This year we came into the tournament with a few more losses than we're used to," said Li. "We had losses to Middlebury, [Claremont-Mudd-Scripps] and Amherst, but this year we have a very young team, with three sophomores in the lineup.

"After every tough loss, though, we came back and improved. We made our biggest improvements the weeks after tough losses, which demonstrate this team's hunger and competitive spirit. We learned from those losses and used them as fuel for the fire."

Williams' six consecutive national championships tie an NCAA women's tennis record, as Stanford won six Division I titles in a row from 1986 to 1991. The Ephs lead Division III with eight titles overall.

Amherst defeated Claremont-Mudd-Scripps, 5-0, in the match for third place. It was Amherst's third time finishing third, and Emory's third year as runner-up.

In individual competition, Middlebury sophomore Lok Sze Leung defeated Claremont-Mudd-Scripps senior Kristin Lim, 6-1, 6-3, to win the singles crown. In the doubles final, Amherst juniors Jordan Brewer and Gabby Devlin defeated Claremont-Mudd-Scripps' Lim and freshman Caroline Ward, 4-6, 6-3, 7-6 (6), to give the Lord Jeffs their third consecutive doubles title. Brewer and Devlin won in 2011; Devlin partnered with Laura Danzig in 2012.
