

## Highlights

**Armstrong wins record eighth national championship:** Armstrong took care of business in similar fashion as the previous year in the May 11 final of the 2013 NCAA Division II Women's Tennis Championships at the Surprise (Ariz.) Tennis & Racquet Complex.

Just as they did in 2012, the Pirates beat Brigham Young-Hawaii, 5-2, earning their second consecutive title and sixth in nine years. It was Armstrong's eighth overall title, as the Pirates moved ahead of Brigham Young-Hawaii for most championships among Division II women's teams.

After watching his men's team lose its title match to Barry, 5-4, earlier in the day, Simon Earnshaw, who coaches both Armstrong teams, was pleased to see the women prevail.

"We beat the No. 1, 3 and 4 teams in the nation in back-to-back-to-back days, but we got a lot of heart and just like the men, we kept fighting," said Earnshaw, who has coached at the Savannah, Ga., university for 14 years. "And we were able to turn some big, big matches around."

As it did in its quarterfinal win over top-ranked Barry, the Armstrong women's championship-clinching victory came at No. 4 singles from Marlen Hacke, whose 4-6, 6-2, 6-0 score against Brigham Young-Hawaii's Marietta Tuionetoa sealed the title.

Hacke said she was "just playing. We knew that the first big step was Barry on Thursday in the second round (nee quarterfinals). And after we beat them, we were pretty confident to go in the semis, then also in the finals. At the same time, we know that something can happen."

Armstrong got off to a strong start in doubles, winning two of the three matches to take a 2-1 lead into singles play. Hacke and Olga Kalodzitsa beat Brigham Young-Hawaii's Marika Kobayashi and Tuionetoa, 8-3, at No. 2 to give Earnshaw only the second undefeated doubles team in his head coaching career. The Brigham Young-Hawaii pair also had entered the match undefeated.

"That was a special match right there," Earnshaw said.

The Seaside struck first in singles, with Annie Hwang polishing off Armstrong's Aleksandra Filipovski, 6-1, 6-1, at No. 1. Armstrong regained the lead at No. 3, when Barbora Krtickova beat Kobayashi 6-2, 7-6(1), and at No. 6, when Natasa Vukovic beat Jade Griffin 0-6, 6-4, 6-4.

Needing one more point to secure the championship, Hacke turned a first-set setback into a convincing victory.

"I actually told them last night, 'Sometimes when you reach the fourth or even the fifth hour of matches, things can turn in your favor,'" Earnshaw said. "You've just got to give yourself a chance."

"We don't know really what to expect and it was very close until the end, again," Hacke said. "We're all experienced [at] nationals and I guess that helped us a lot [in the final]."

Also helpful was the cheering presence of the Armstrong men. After losing their title match on the last points of their last singles match, the Pirates returned en masse to support the women in their afternoon quest.

"I was a little worried how that was going to be," said Earnshaw, citing emotional carryover. "I know some of them were very, very upset after their match. Normally, I'd be annoyed if they were kind of smiling this close to a loss."

It was the fourth time both Earnshaw-coached teams had played for a Division II title in the same year, but the first time both were not victorious.
