Highlights

Wartburg rallies to second straight track crown: Wartburg overcame a difficult first day at the NCAA Division III Indoor Track and field Championships to win the women's 1,600-meter relay and clinch a second straight team title.

Wartburg finished with 33 points in the women's meet, just ahead of Wisconsin-Oshkosh (29). St. Lawrence was next with 24 points, followed by Illinois Wesleyan and Chicago (21).

"That is part of it," said Wartburg coach Marcus Newsom, whose team was a big pre-meet favorite before struggling in several events. "Athletics is about overcoming adversity, and we overcame adversity this weekend."

Wartburg's women, the defending indoor and outdoor national champions, took the lead March 13 at DePauw's Hollenmeister Track with a third-place finish by sophomore Faith Burt in the 55-meter dash, then lost it when Wisconsin-Oshkosh scored 13 points in the shot put. The Knights, which entered with the meet with the No. 1 qualifying time in the 1,600-meter relay, entered that final event needing to finish first or second to win the national title.

With Nevada Morrison taking a quick lead, the Knights never trailed and after solid legs by Jenny Kordick and Chelsey Jacobs, Burt pulled away on the anchor leg to give the Knights the best Division III time (3:48.73) of the season in the event and the team title.

Not that the Knights knew about the last part.

Newsom said he opted not to tell the team the situation entering the final event.

"I'm glad he didn't," said Burt, running the anchor in the 1,600-meter relay for the first time. "It would have brought a lot more stress than what there was already. I had some idea that since it was the last race, we needed to put it all on the line in order for us to come out on top."

"Whatever position my team put me in, I was going to keep it there."

The final day of the meet also featured two meet individual records.

Anna Heim of Moravian, who won the women's pole vault at 13 feet, 7¾ inches, became the first Division III woman to clear four meters (4.16) in the championship meet.

Senior Kristen Bates of Messiah also won two national titles in a half-hour span. She claimed the 55-meter hurdles with a Division III season-best 8.00 seconds, then clinched a national championship with a ninth-place finish in the 800-meter event-finale in the pentathlon.

She won the pentathlon with a Division III season's best 3,555 points.

"I was just grateful I didn't have to run the 800 and go straight to the 55," Bates said.

Bates had finished second in the 55 hurdles and third in the pentathlon at the indoor national championships last year.

"At the beginning of this year, I was going for it," she said. "That was the idea."

Also in the Division III track events March 13:

* Senior Marie Borner of Bethel (Minnesota) won the women's mile for a second time in three years in 4:50.20 after finishing second in the event last season. The time was a Division III season best and a Hollenmeister track record.

* Calvin junior Rachel Boerner won the women's 400 meters with a Division III season-best 55.95.

* Senior Callen Martin of Wilmington (Ohio) won the women's 55-meter dash in a Division III season's best 6.98.

* Sophomore Emily Schudrowitz of St. Norbert won the women's 800 meters in a Division III season-best and track record 2:09.24.

* Junior Wendy Pavlus of St. Lawrence won the women's 5,000 meters with a Division III season-best 16:59.40.
